

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. The Angel Light Academy is hosting a Youth Leadership “Kick-Off” Conference, which is a 2-day leadership program that teaches leadership traits, communication skills, problem solving, teamwork and community service. CID funds will be used towards the Above and Beyond Gala, which raises funds for the Youth Leadership Conference and the Junior Leader program.
- 2. The Riverside County In-Home Support Services (IHSS) program strives to assist seniors and persons with disabilities to remain safely in their homes. IHSS Public Authority and community partners throughout the county coordinate the Caregiver Appreciation event to acknowledge the invaluable services that caregivers provide. The event will include special training presentations, a resource fair, and raffle prizes. CID funds will be used to offset the costs of this event.
- 3. The City of Palm Springs will host the Annual Veterans Day Parade on November 11, 2025. This parade honors all who served and provides an opportunity for the community to say thank you to all our veterans for their service. CID funds will be used towards parade expenses such as staging, pyrotechnics, lighting, sound, advertising, and CHP staffing.
- 4. First Community Baptist Church is hosting the MLK Weekend Celebration on January 17–19, 2026. The event will feature participation from several local schools, with students competing in an essay contest, oratorical contest, basketball tournament, track and field competition, and chess tournament. CID funds will be used towards expenses, marketing, transportation and food.

5. Palm Springs Art Museum (PSAM) is the largest arts cultural institution in the Coachella Valley. Guadalupe's House Party is a celebration of the exhibition Guadalupe Rosales | Tzahualli: Mi memoria en tu reflejo, which highlights 1990s Chicano youth culture in Los Angeles and Southern California through photography, sound, sculpture, and archival materials. CID funds will be used towards the art showcases and entertainment.
6. The Exception is a nonprofit organization dedicated to improving the quality of life for vulnerable populations in Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. In partnership with UCR Palm Desert, Riverside County Probation, and Riverside County Office of Education, The Exception will host Raising the Future, a transformative community event designed to empower opportunity youth and their families with the resources, mentorship, and skills needed to succeed. CID funds will be used to support the expenses of the event and scholarships for youth participants.
7. CAL FIRE and Riverside County hosted the CALFIRE Expo at the Riverside County Fairground. This event offered students the opportunity to engage directly with fire service professionals, experience live demonstrations, and explore pathways into emergency response, public safety, and fire technology careers. CID funds will be used to cover the cost of lunch and drinks provided for the students.
