

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Mrs. B's Table is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$750. Funding will support the annual Toy Shoppe holiday event in the San Jacinto Valley, providing toys, food, clothing, and holiday supplies to more than 150 low-income and shelter-based families. The event fosters community unity and ensures every child experiences the joy and dignity of the season.
  
2. Black Voices of the Valley is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$3,500. Funding will support community programs including the Night of Black Excellence Scholarship Ceremony, Kidpreneurship Event, Juneteenth Celebration, Turkey Drive, and Toy Drive, all focused on uplifting Black and Brown youth through education, mentorship, and cultural empowerment in the Hemet-San Jacinto area.
  
3. Beaumont-Cherry Valley Recreation and Park District is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support the District's 6th Annual Fundraising Golf Tournament, which raises funds to enhance parks, recreation programs, and community facilities serving residents of the Fifth District.
  
4. Calimesa Youth Baseball & Softball is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support the launch of Calimesa's first organized youth sports league for ages 4–17, providing affordable access to baseball

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and softball programs. Funds will be used to purchase essential equipment and supplies for the league's inaugural Spring 2026 season, promoting recreation, teamwork, and youth engagement in the community.

5. The Unforgettables Foundation is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support the Child Burial Assistance Program, which provides financial assistance to low-income families in the Fifth District who have lost a child, helping cover burial and cremation costs. The program also connects families with grief counseling and related support services, offering compassionate relief during times of loss.
6. In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) Public Authority is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support the annual Caregiver Appreciation Event, recognizing the essential work of caregivers who assist seniors and individuals with disabilities. The event includes training sessions, recognition ceremonies, and resource fairs, benefiting caregivers countywide including more than 14,000 in District 5.
7. Riverside County Foundation on Aging is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$5,000. Funding will support the Grocery Market Gift Card/Nutrition Support Program, providing grocery gift cards to low-income seniors in cities within District 5 to promote food security, independence, and dignity among older adults.
