C.E.O. RECOMMENDATION: Approve

In 1989, the Colmac Air Quality Enhancement Fund was established through one of the provisions of the settlement agreement which resolved litigation between Colmac Energy, Inc., and the County over the construction of a biomass energy plant near the unincorporated community of Mecca in the Southern Coachella Valley. Among other provisions, the settlement provides for an annual payment of \$250,000 to fund projects which enhance air quality within the Coachella Valley. On February 3, 1998 (Agenda Item No. 3.6), the Board of Supervisors delegated administration of the Air Quality Enhancement Fund to the Executive Office, and established the Coachella Valley Air Quality Advisory Committee (Advisory Committee) consisting of three members: The Fourth District Supervisor or his/her representative and representatives from the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) and Coachella Valley Association of Governments (CVAG).

On September 13, 2021, the Riverside County Purchasing Department on behalf of the Executive Office issued a Request for Application (RIVCO-2021-RFA-0000338) for submission to the Executive Office by January 5, 2022, seeking projects that will enhance air quality in the Coachella Valley. College of the Desert and CVAG were awarded a landscape contract certification program for two years and \$80,000.

On February 25, 2025, the Board of Supervisors approved the first amendment to extend the term of the agreement and increase the funding made to the Grantees for the Landscape certification program by \$40,000 through June 2025.

The County, CVAG, and the College of the Desert desire to amend the Agreement to extend the term of the agreement and increase the funding made to the Grantees for the Landscape Certification Program through June 30, 2026, for an additional \$40,000.

The advisory committee discussed the proposal and unanimously agreed to move it forward to the Board of Supervisors for consideration.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Approval of these funding recommendations will further assist clean air goals for the region.

Additional Fiscal Information

Funding for the proposed projects is derived from money collected as part of the settlement agreement with Colmac Energy, Inc. and has no impact on the general fund.

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO GRANT AWARD AND AUTHORIZATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND
THE COACHELLA VALLEY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS AND
COLLEGE OF THE DESERT**

This Amendment (hereafter the "Amendment 2") to the Grant Award and Authorization Agreement is made and entered into as of this 21st day of October 2025 by and between the County of Riverside (the County ") a political subdivision of the State of California, and the Coachella Valley Association of Governments ("CVAG") and College of the Desert (collectively the "Grantees").

RECITALS

Whereas, County and Grantees entered into a Grant Award and Authorization Agreement on May 10, 2022 (County Board Item No. 3.3), hereinafter "Agreement", to address the regional need for air quality enhancement projects; and

Whereas, County and Grantees entered into a 1st Amendment Grant Award and Authorization Agreement on February 25, 2025 (County Board Item No. 3.12), hereinafter "1st Amendment", to extend the term of the agreement and adjust the award amount; address the regional need for air quality enhancement projects; and

Whereas, the County and Grantees desire to amend the Agreement to extend the term of the agreement and to provide an additional forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to continue the Grantees for the Landscape Certification Program.

Now, Therefore, in joint and mutual exercise of their powers and in consideration of the mutual covenants herein and other valuable consideration, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Section 3. Term is deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

"This Agreement will be effective upon final execution of the Agreement and will terminate on June 30, 2026. The approved project must be completed within this term. Extensions of this time may be requested in writing and sent to the address set forth in Section 12. Extensions of time are considered discretionary and are reviewed on a case-by-case basis."

2. Section 7. Payments subsection (a) is deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

"(a) The total payments to the Grantee under this Agreement will not exceed one-hundred and sixty thousand dollars (\$160,000.00) which will be used to support the Project.

4. Authority to Enter Agreement. Each Party to this Agreement warrants to the other that it is duly organized and existing and that it and the respective signatories have full right and authority to enter into and consummate this Agreement and all related documents and bind the parties thereto.
5. Use of Electronic (Digital) Signatures. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which will be an original, but all of which together will constitute one instrument. Each party of this Agreement agrees to the use of electronic signatures, such as digital signatures that meet the requirements of the California Uniform Electronic Transactions Act ("CUETA") Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1633.1 to 1633.17), for executing this Agreement. The parties further agree that the electronic signatures of the parties included in this Agreement are intended to authenticate this writing and to have the same force and effect as manual signatures. Electronic signature means an electronic sound, symbol, or process attached to or logically associated with an electronic record and executed or adopted by a person with the intent to sign the electronic record pursuant to the CUETA as amended from time to time. The CUETA authorizes use of an electronic signature for transactions and contracts among parties in California, including a government agency. Digital signature means an electronic identifier, created by computer, intended by the party using it to have the same force and effect as the use of a manual signature, and shall be reasonably relied upon by the parties. For purposes of this section, a digital signature is a type of "electronic signature" as defined in subdivision (i) of Section 1633.2 of the Civil Code.


