2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Cajalco Road and Carroll Street Traffic Signal and Safety Lighting Project, in the Community of Mead Valley;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 12, 2025, at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

On December 3, 2024 (Agenda Item 3.82), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors approved the Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside (County) and Deemarco Limited Partnership (Developer) for the Cajalco Road and Carroll Street Traffic Signal Project (Project) in the Community of Mead Valley. The Agreement established the terms of the parties' responsibilities and cost sharing. The County is designated as the lead agency for the construction of the Project.

At this "T" intersection, Carroll Street is a two-lane local road that extends southerly from Cajalco Road. Cajalco Road is a two-lane road that travels in the east-west direction with a left-turn lane for westbound vehicles turning south onto Carroll Street. Carroll Street is currently controlled by a stop sign while the vehicles on Cajalco Road continue driving without having to stop. The area in the immediate vicinity includes vacant land on the north half and south-east quadrant of the intersection and recently developed commercial land on the south-west quadrant of the intersection.

Project construction will include installation of traffic signal poles with mast-arms, safety lighting, traffic signal cabinets, video and radar detection units, installation of new thermoplastic and paint traffic striping and pavement markings, roadside signs, and other associated work.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

The project proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Cajalco Road and Carroll Street. This improvement is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because it does not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities. Additionally, as discussed in the attached Notice of Exemption (NOE), actions related to nesting

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surveys and burrowing owl are requirements of any covered project within the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan and are not deemed mitigation. See the attached NOE for additional details.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements at the Cajalco Road and Carroll Street "T" intersection.

The work is scheduled to begin in early 2026. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$307,844. The proposed improvements will be funded with Combined Improvement Fund and Developer Contributions.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded by County from gas tax.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Cajalco Road and Carroll Street in the Mead Valley area of Riverside County.

The work involves installing traffic signal poles and mast-arms, traffic signal cabinets and pullboxes, minor pavement widening, removing existing traffic striping, installing new traffic stripes, pavement markings, and retroreflective pavement markers, removing existing traffic signs, and installing new traffic signs.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS: The installation of a signal and restriping of the road will be conducted by the County, who is a permittee as defined by the Western Riverside Multi-Species Habitat Conservation Plan (WRMSHCP). The project is subject to compliance within the WRMSHCP. The project is outside of designated MSHCP Criteria Cells; however, it is still subject to compliance with the WRCMSHCP. Under Section 7.1 Covered Activities Outside Criteria Area and PQP lands of the MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance projects, are Covered Activities and are not subject to survey or mitigation requirements outside criteria area and Public/Quasi-Public Lands. These covered activities are subject to compliance with Best Management Practices as described in Appendix C of the WRMSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – August 31), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act.

Within 30 days prior to the beginning of ground disturbance, a pre-construction presence/absence survey for the Burrowing Owl shall be conducted by a qualified County biologist, as required by the WRMSHCP. This can be performed simultaneously with the nesting survey if it is required.

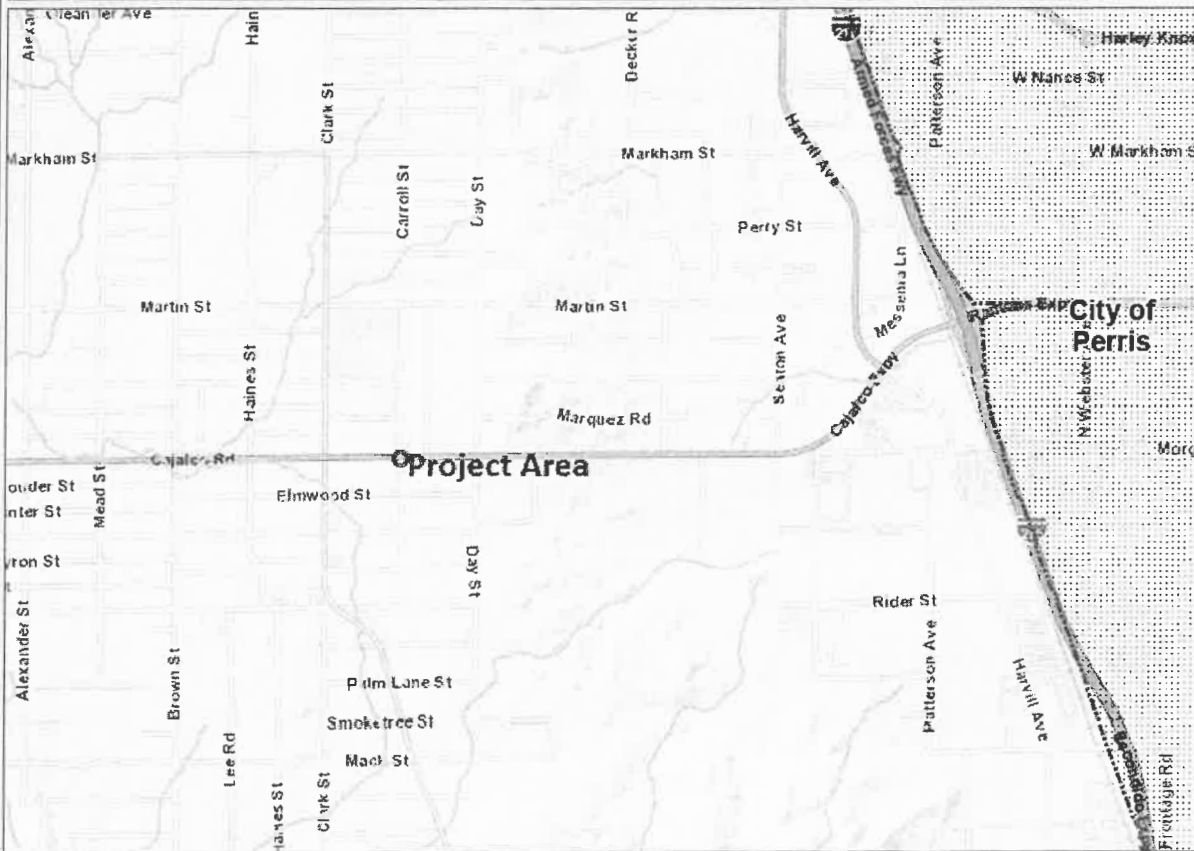

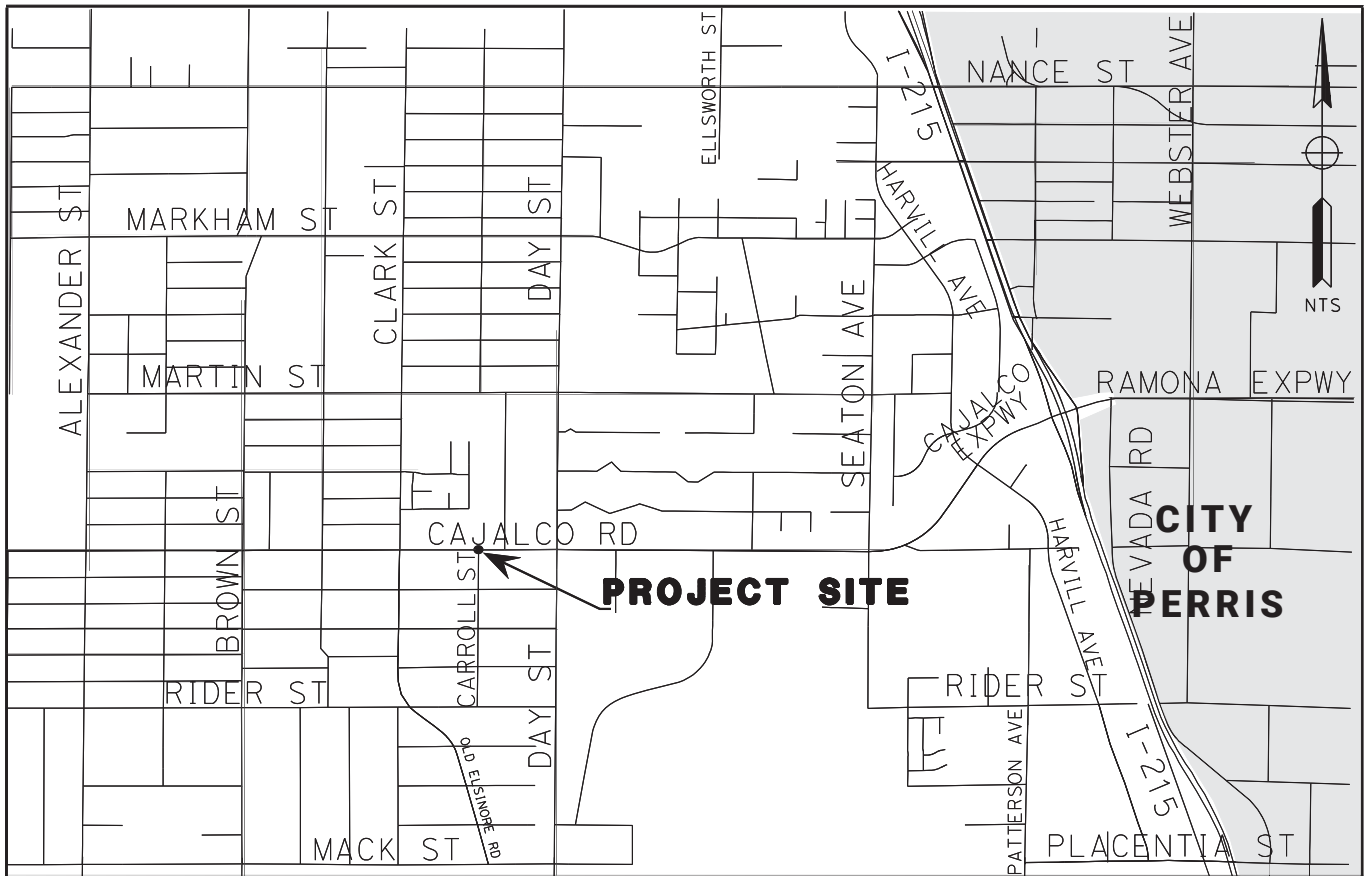
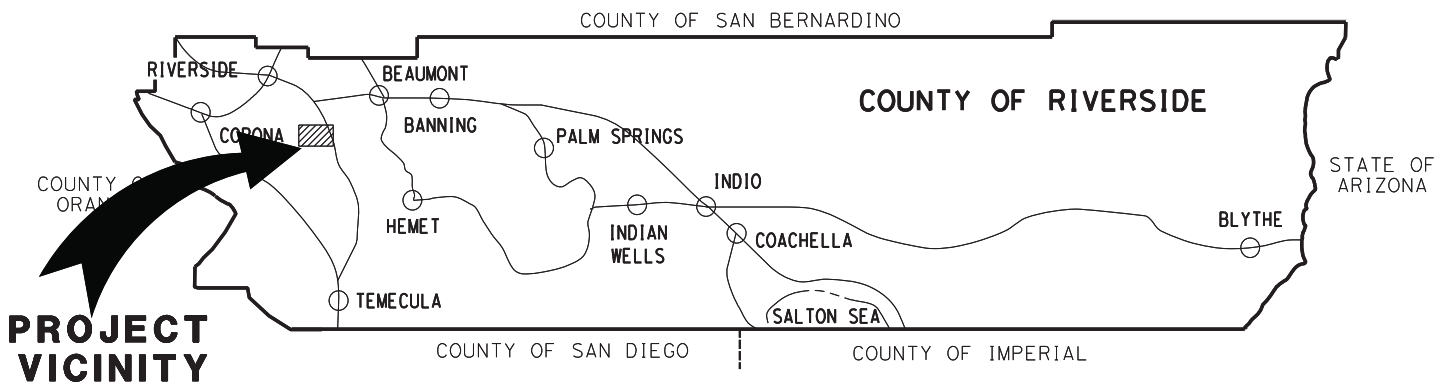
