**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the Riverside County Foundation on Aging, Inc. (\$2,500.00) will benefit the Grocery Market Gift Card/Nutrition Support Program for seniors throughout the Second District.
2. The donation to the Fox Theater Foundation (\$3,000.00) will support the Students at the Fox (SAF) education and outreach program, which provides complimentary tickets for local students to attend live theater performances that align with school arts and literature curriculum. The program expands access to cultural enrichment opportunities for low-income youth across Second District school districts.
3. The donation to the City of Corona Senior Center (\$4,000.00) will benefit the Senior Travel Program which allows active seniors, who are no longer able to drive, the opportunity to explore various amenities throughout Southern California such as local museums and aquariums.
4. The donation to the Unforgettables Foundation (\$4,000.00) will support the Riverside County Child Burial Assistance Program, a continuing effort to assist grieving families throughout Riverside County who are facing the sudden and tragic loss of a child by subsidizing burial or cremation costs, handling funeral home invoices, cemetery fees and urn or casket costs.

5. The donation to Angels Over Cliffs (\$1,000.00) will support the Shine for a Cause event benefiting programs that help families transition from homelessness to permanent housing through case management, housing assistance, and essential support services.
6. The donation to American Legion Norco Post 328, INC. (\$4,000.00) will support the Boys State and Norco High School scholarship programs, which provide local students with opportunities to explore civic leadership and pursue advanced education. Scholarships assist with tuition, books, computers, and other academic expenses for youth preparing for college and future careers.
7. The donation to NDR Therapeutic Riding/ NDR Therapy Services (\$4,000.00) will help children, adults, and veterans with disabilities experience life changing equine-assisted activities by providing a safe, inclusive environment that builds confidence and independence.
