BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:

In 1929, the Temecula Public Cemetery was incorporated into California's newly established Special Districts. Today, the Cemetery District is overseen by five volunteer trustees. Trustees of the Temecula Public Cemetery District must make a personal commitment to represent the residents and property taxpayers of the District by providing desired cemetery services at an affordable price, attending regular monthly meetings and special meetings, and actively participating in activities and seminars which provide education and information necessary for the operation of the District.

Rosie Vanderhaak has lived in Temecula since 1971 and joined the Temecula Public Cemetery's Board of Directors in 2011. Mrs. Vanderhaak is a graduate of the University of Connecticut and has enjoyed a long career serving our community through the public library.

Michael Dugan attended Queens College in Queens, New York prior to serving 4 years in the United States Navy. After serving in the Navy, Mr. Dugan accepted a position with Schindler Elevator Co. where he became Superintendent of Field Operations. Following retirement from Schindler, he accepted a position with St Jeanne's De Lestonnac School in Temecula as a Physical Education Instructor. Mr. Dugan has served on the Temecula Public Cemetery District for 16 years.
