BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The Joslyn Center provides health, recreational, educational, and social programs along with information, referral volunteer and support services for older adults. Wine and All That Jazz fundraiser is going to be held on November 5, 2025, at the Classic Club. Proceeds from this annual fundraiser will benefit the program and services for older adults in the Coachella Valley. CID funds will be used to support centerpiece expenses for their event.
2. The Coachella Valley High School Football Booster Club was established in 2017 with the mission of supporting students- athletes both on and off the field. The goal is to build a strong foundation of teamwork, discipline and pride while helping students succeed academically and athletically. CID funds will be used to cover the cost of equipment and uniforms.
3. Lake Cahuilla Veterans Regional Park specifically honors our veterans and provides an inclusive space for community gatherings. The Veterans Fishing Derby is an annual tradition that has been in operation since 2023, honoring our veterans and engaging the community in outdoor recreation. On November 8, 2025, Rivco Parks will celebrate the newly developed reopening of Lake Cahuilla Veterans Regional Park along with the Veterans Fishing Derby. CID funds will be used to cover the expenses for entertainment, car how, drone show and inflatable play area.
4. Riverside University Health System will host the 36th Annual Festival of Trees on November 25, 2025 at the Riverside Convention Center. This event raises funds to support the critical work at RUHS Pediatric Unit, Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit and the Child Abuse a Neglect Unit. CID funds will be used to upgrade ventilators and provide uniform monitors for their beds.
