BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the Eastvale Chamber of Commerce (\$1,500.00) will support the 4th Annual Fire and Police Appreciation event, which honors and recognizes the dedication and service of local first responders who serve the Eastvale community.
2. The donation to the City of Norco (\$1,500.00) will support the Annual State of the City Address, highlighting the City's progress, initiatives, and continued commitment to serving the community.
3. The donation to Community Outreach Ministry (\$2,000.00) will benefit the 25th Annual Angel Tree Christmas Party, serving 200 at-promise children from Lakeland Village, Lake Elsinore, and Canyon Lake whose parents are currently incarcerated. The event provides clothing, food, and holiday gifts while introducing youth to ongoing programs including STEAM mentorship, summer camps, and vocational training opportunities.
4. The donation to the Inland Empire Community Foundation fbo Thunder Cares Fund (\$4,000.00) will contribute to the Thunder Cares Program which provides funding to local charities, youth sports initiatives, military and first responder support efforts, and other community-based organizations serving residents in need.
5. The donation to Rubidoux High School (\$2,500.00) will support the annual Falcon Festival, which features student fundraisers, performances, and community

engagement activities. The event connects families with local businesses, educational resources, and health and social service organizations.

6. The donation to American Legion Post 500 (\$4,000.00) will fund essential facility improvements and provide sponsorships for high school students to participate in a week-long government leadership program in Sacramento.
7. The donation to Machado Family Giving (\$2,500.00) will support the Magic in Our Children event, which provides toys, bicycles, food, and hygiene products to more than 6,000 low-income families during the holidays.
