BACKGROUND:

Summary

Section 66006(b) of the Government Code requires the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, on behalf of the County, to prepare an annual report of fees collected for development projects within 180 days after the last day of each fiscal year. Pursuant to the cited government code, the attached report provides to the public the following financial information on each of the County's currently adopted Area Drainage Plans for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2025: beginning and ending balances, fees collected, interest earned, transfers to zones, refunds and expenditures.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Annual Report on Financial Status of Area Drainage Plans provides a report on fees imposed on new development within the plan area. The residents and businesses will benefit from the fees as they are a funding mechanism to ensure that existing residents do not bear the entire tax burden for facilities needed to accommodate future development proposals.
