BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to Voices for Children (\$4,000.00) will support the Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) Program to enhance child safety, stability and quality of life by connecting them with valuable resources and representing their best interests through advocacy.
2. The donation to UNITY Youth Advocacy Council – CNUUSD (\$5,000.00) will cover airfare, transportation and food costs for local high school students to attend YouthQuest, a one-day youth advocacy and leadership conference hosted by the California Youth Advocacy Network in Sacramento, California.
3. The donation to the City of Norco (\$4,000.00) will support several veterans events that honor and recognize local service members, while fostering community engagement and civic pride. These events provide an opportunity for residents to come together in appreciation of the sacrifices made by veterans and their families and help strengthen Norco’s long-standing commitment to supporting the military community.
4. The donation to the Rubidoux High School Choir (\$2,000.00) will benefit students participating in music-based programs and performances that enhance their artistic development and engagement with the community. The choir provides youth with opportunities to learn a diverse repertoire, perform at local and regional events, and represent their school with pride while building confidence, teamwork, and cultural appreciation through the arts.
