BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Rotary Club of Temecula Foundation** - \$5,000- The funding will be utilized to provide holiday baskets for low-income families in the Temecula Valley Unified School District.
2. **Rotary Club of Temecula Valley-New Generations Foundation-** \$5,000- The funds will cover the cost of attendance of 20 high school students, to the RYLA-Rotary Youth Leadership Camp.
3. **Community Outreach Ministry-** \$2,000- The funding will support the 25th Annual Angel Tree Christmas party, an event that will provide children of incarcerated parents with Christmas gifts such as clothing and food.
4. **Temecula Sunrise Rotary Foundation-** \$5,000- This funding will be used to support 2 programs (1) Literacy Program, a program that provides age-appropriate books to kids and (2) the Safety Town Program, a program that provides hands-on safety education to children.
