BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. ABC Recovery Center is a non-profit substance use disorder treatment facility in Indio. Their mission is to provide an environment for individuals with substance use disorders to achieve lifelong sobriety and re-enter the community as healthy and responsible individuals. The "ABC Gala" is an annual fundraising and community engagement event that is taking place on Tuesday, November 4th at the Fantasy Springs Casino and Resort. The event serves as a platform to highlight our organizational achievements, raise crucial operating funds, and foster relationships with community leaders and supporters, all in service of improving mental health and recovery outcomes in our service areas. CID funds will be used to support the general operations and mission of the ABC Recovery Center.

2. The Angel Light Academy's Leadership Service Award program is a part of the Youth Leadership Conference, which teaches leadership traits, communication skills, problem solving, teamwork, and community service. Students spend two days with highly trained and qualified facilitators experiencing leadership in such a way that they can take the learning and apply it to real-life situations. CID funds will be used to create and implement the Leadership Services Award, which will be awarded to students who attend the Youth Leadership Conference, and move to join the Junior Leader Program.
