5. Approve the project's proposed budget as shown in Attachment "A".



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated July 29, 2025 (Agenda Item 3.75), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Hostettler Road Drainage Improvements Project, in the Community of Temescal Valley, a joint project of the County of Riverside Transportation Department and Riverside County Flood Control & Water Conservation District (RCFC&WCD).

The project consists of constructing drainage improvements to alleviate flooding from the Temescal Wash on Hostettler Road, approximately 900 feet southwest of Temescal Canyon Road, in the Community of Temescal Valley of Riverside County.

The drainage improvements will include the construction of a double, 2-foot high and 4-foot wide, reinforced concrete box (RCB) culvert across Hostettler Road. The culvert will be approximately 80 feet in length and will have a reinforced concrete headwall with wingwalls at the inlet, and a reinforced concrete end wall at the outlet. At the RCB inlet, a 6-inch-thick concrete access ramp, approximately 271-foot long and 9-foot wide, will be constructed along the north and west boundaries of the east parcel to divert surface flow to the culvert. At the RCB outlet, an approximately 231-foot-long earthen trapezoidal channel 4 to 5-foot deep will be constructed and will extend to the Temescal Wash westerly.

Road improvements will require removal of full-width segments of the existing concrete pavement and constructing a new extended concrete pavement segment. Additional improvements include construction of concrete curb, installation of metal beam guardrail, placement of traffic striping and thermoplastic pavement markings, salvage/removal and installation of new roadside signs, and other associated work.

On July 29, 2025 (Agenda Item 3.77), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors approved a cooperative agreement between RCFC&WCD and the County of Riverside Transportation Department that sets forth the mutual understandings with respect to design, bidding,

administration, construction, inspection, ownership and maintenance of the improvements. RCFC&WCD will provide 100% of the project funding within RCFC&WCD's right of way and will be responsible for the maintenance of the culvert facility outside the road right of way.

During the advertisement period, four addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award.

The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda did not increase the engineer's cost estimate. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1, 2, 3, and 4.

The Contract includes the following schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule:	Hostettler Road Drainage Improvements
Alternative Bid Schedule 1:	Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District (EVMWD) 20-Inch and 6-Inch Waterline Relocation

EVMWD has concurred the bid prices proposed by Riverside Construction Company, Inc. for Alternative Bid Schedule 1. RCFC&WCD's cooperative agreement provides sufficient funding to cover EVMWD's relocation work, which RCFC&WCD agrees to cover while EVMWD executes a cooperative agreement with the County of Riverside Transportation Department and their board.

The contractor, Riverside Construction Company, Inc., is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the contract documents.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this drainage improvements project is to reduce flooding over Hostettler Road and to improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic. Hostettler Road is one of only two roadways utilized by residents of the Horsethief Canyon Ranch community.

Full closure of Hostettler Road for sixty consecutive calendar days will be necessary to complete the construction of the double RCB culvert, EVMWD waterline relocations, and construction of roadway concrete pavement. During the sixty calendar days road closure, residential access will be provided and through traffic will be directed to use alternate detour route.

Construction is anticipated to begin in fall/winter 2025 and will take approximately two months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2025/2026 and will be funded with Flood Control funds.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A total of seven bids were received on Wednesday September 17, 2025, ranging from \$1,234,271 to \$2,807,257. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The low bidder, Riverside Construction Company, In., submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$1,234,271 which is \$201,292 (14%) below the engineer's cost estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to Riverside Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$1,234,271.

Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and Riverside Construction Company, Inc., hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, Hostettler Road Drainage Improvements, Approximately 900-Foot Southwest of Temescal Canyon Road, Community of Temescal Valley, Project No. D5-0041, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of **2024** as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda (**Four**), (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

The County provides survey stakes marking the location of ESA fence limits for Contractor's reference and use in the performance of trees and vegetation clearing work.

Refer to Section 17-2, Clearing and Grubbing, on pages 34 through 36 of the Special Provisions regarding trees and vegetation clearing provisions.

No grubbing or disturbance of soil will be permitted until the WPCP is approved by the County.

Note: At the discretion of the Engineer, and if WPCP is approved before the first NPT is issued or during the first NTP period, Contractor may start dewatering and grading outside the road right-of-way (channel grading) operations during the first NTP period.

The contractor will have **20 additional Working Days** (in addition to the assigned **60 calendar days** for work completion), to complete the procurement of materials and performance of work required under the first NTP.

For work performed under the first NTP, daily working hours shall be between **7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.** from **Monday through Friday**, except County-observed holidays, unless otherwise approved by the Engineer. Exceptions and specific work schedules shall be submitted to the Engineer for consideration.

Daily working hours shall be between **7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.** from **Monday through Friday**, for work performed under the first NTP; and between **7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.** from **Monday through Sunday**, for work performed under the second NTP; except County-observed holidays, unless otherwise approved by the Engineer. Exceptions and specific work schedules shall be submitted to the Engineer for consideration.

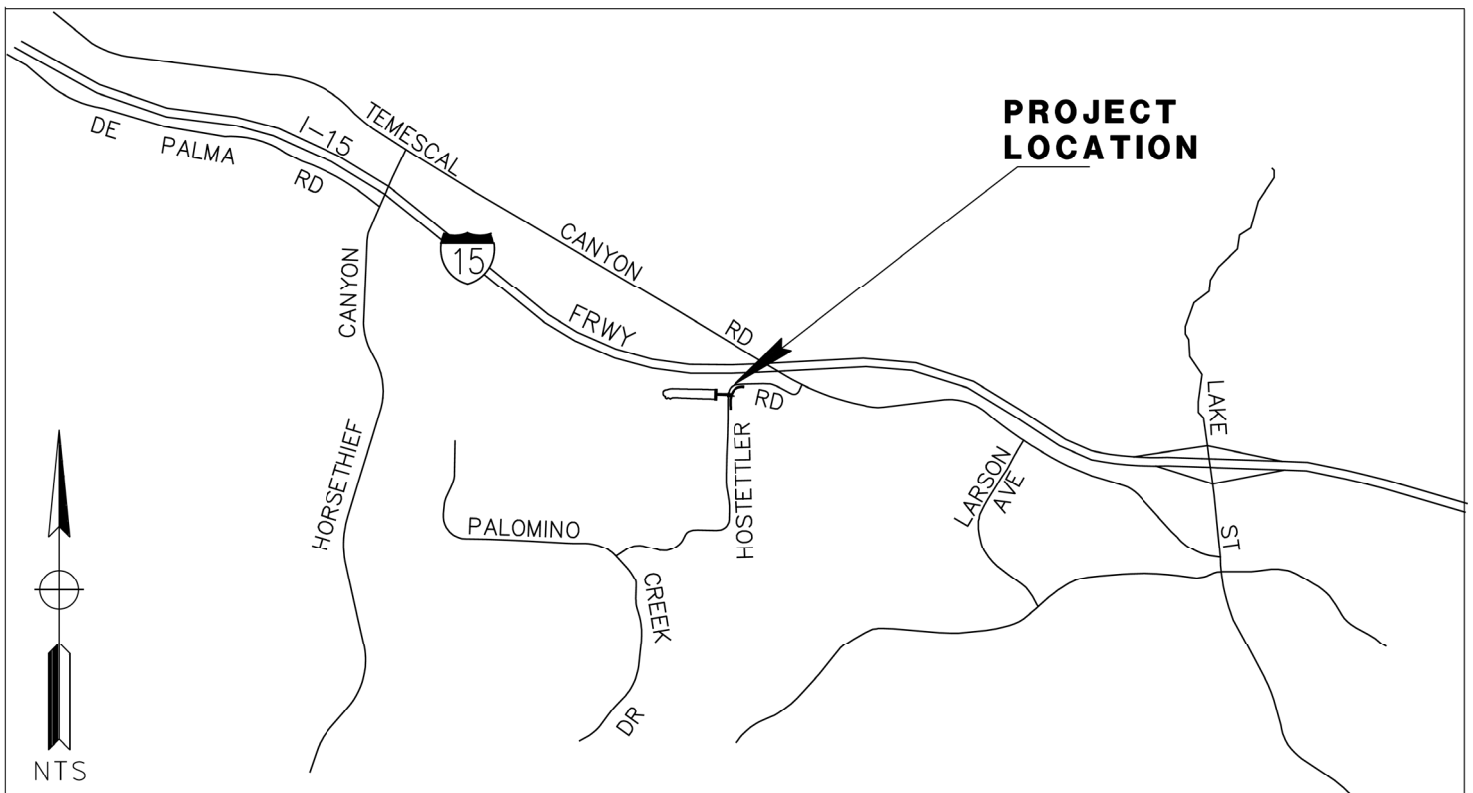
