- By Supervisor Medina: Duane Roberts, who passed away on November 1, 2025, at the age of 88. Known as the California food entrepreneur and hotelier credited with creating frozen burritos and reviving the Mission Inn Hotel & Spa in Riverside, CA. He led a seven-year, \$55 million restoration, reopening the historic landmark in 1992. He supported pets, education, veterans, healthcare, and the arts. Additionally, he supported Olive Crest, and Mary S. Roberts Pet Adoption Center, which is named after his mother.

The Board of Supervisors commemorates his service to the County of Riverside.
