BACKGROUND:

Summary

The City of Jurupa Valley approved the Third Amendment to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement (Third Amendment) for a modification of the level of service for FY25/26 through FY27/28. This Third Amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Office by the deletion of one (1) Community Oriented Policing Officer and an addition of one (1) Traffic Enforcement Officer. County Counsel has approved the Third Amendment as to form.

The Sheriff's Office has included the cost estimate in its budget; therefore, no budget adjustment is necessary. County Counsel has approved the Third Amendment as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is a Third Amendment between the City of Jurupa Valley and the Sheriff's Office for law enforcement services, which the City of Jurupa Valley approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through the Sheriff's Office Board-approved rates.

THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT





LEVEL OF SERVICE

Average Patrol Services

180 fully supported hours per day (Approximate equivalent of 35 Deputy Sheriff positions @ 1,884 annual productive hours per position).

Dedicated Positions

One (1) Sheriff's Sergeant position

One (1) Sheriff's Traffic/Motor Sergeant position

Eight (8) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Zone Policing Officers

Four (4) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Traffic Enforcement Officers

Five (5) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Motorcycle Enforcement Officers

One (1) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Community Oriented Policing

Two (2) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) position – Commercial Enforcement Deputy

Seven (7) Community Service Officer II positions – Traffic Enforcement/Patrol
