

BACKGROUND:

Summary

Ordinance No. 508 regulates the operation and licensing of fortunetelling businesses within Riverside County. Ordinance 508 provides for fees to be charged by the Sheriff's Officer for the purpose of recovering its costs associated with processing license applications. Currently, the fees charged by the Sheriff's Office have not been updated since 2010, and Ordinance No. 508.3 would amend the fees charged by the Sheriff's Office as they are no longer sufficient to allow for full cost recovery. Fees for the processing of a license application will be increased from \$130 to \$182, and fees for license renewals will be increased from \$111 to \$127, which will now be set forth in Ordinance No. 1003.

The current version of Ordinance No. 508.2 was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on July 13, 2010 (Effective 8/12/2010) (Agenda Item 9.12).

On August 26, 2025, the Board of Supervisors for the County of Riverside approved to adopt an order to initiate Riverside County Ordinance No. 508.3 (Minute Order 3.46).

On October 28, 2025, the Board of Supervisors for the County of Riverside approved to adopt an order to introduce Riverside County Ordinance No. 508.3 (Minute Order 3.33).

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Upon Board approval of the proposed amendments to the related County fee ordinances, the County Ordinances will be updated and made available to the public.

Additional Fiscal Information

According to Board Policy A-67, the Board of Supervisors is to consider the costs associated with preparing, processing and implementing an ordinance amendment in deciding whether to adopt an order initiating the amendment. The adoption of Ordinance No. 508.3 should have no fiscal impact on the county as it is merely an adjustment intended to allow the Sheriff's Office to recover its costs in processing associated license applications.


