BACKGROUND:

Summary

Ordinance No. 558 regulates the operation and licensing of charity bingo games conducted within the County. Formerly, Ordinance No. 558 distinguished between traditional bingo games and remote caller games. However, in July of 2025, the State of California enacted Senate Bill 860, which removed the distinction and unified regulations for traditional and remote caller bingo games.

The purpose of Ordinance No. 558.14 is to update the County's ordinances to comply with changes in state law, and to incorporate Ordinance No. 1003, which will set the fees to be charged by the Sheriff's Office associated with the processing of licenses for bingo games as authorized by Penal Code section 326.5(l)(2).

The current version of Ordinance No. 558.13 was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on June 22, 2010 (Effective 7/22/2010) (Agenda Item 3.2).

On August 26, 2025, the Board of Supervisors for the County of Riverside approved an order to initiate Riverside County Ordinance No. 558.14 (Minute Order 3.46).

On October 28, 2025, the Board of Supervisors for the County of Riverside approved an order to introduce Riverside County Ordinance No. 558.14 (Minute Order 3.34).

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Upon Board approval of the proposed amendments to the related County fee ordinances, the County Ordinances will be updated and made available to the public.

Additional Fiscal Information

According to Board Policy A-67, the Board of Supervisors is to consider the costs associated with preparing, processing and implementing an ordinance amendment in deciding whether to adopt an order initiating the amendment. The adoption of Ordinance No. 558.14 should have no

18 (1) An organization exempt from the payment of the bank and
19 corporation tax by Revenue and Tax Code sections 23701a, 23701b,
20 23701d, 23701e, 23701f, 23701g,

21 23701k), 23701l or 23701w;

22 (2) A mobile home park association;

23 (3) A senior citizens organization; and,

24 (4) Charitable organizations affiliated with a school district."

25
26 **Section 5.** Subsection a. of Section 6 of Ordinance No. 558 is amended to read as

28 "a. Applications for a bingo license or a renewal thereof shall be filed

1 with the office of the Sheriff of Riverside County on forms prescribed by the
2 Sheriff and shall be signed under penalty of perjury.”

3 **Section 6.** Subsection b. of Section 6 of Ordinance No. 558 is repealed in its entirety.

5 **Section 7.** Existing Subsection c. of Section 6 of Ordinance No. 558 is relettered

7 “c. A separate application must be completed for each property location

9 **Section 8.** Existing Subsections d. through i. of Section 6 of Ordinance No. 558 are
10 relettered Subsections c. through h. respectively.

11 **Section 9.** Subsection (3) of now-Subsection e. of Section 6 of Ordinance No. 558 is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 “(3) not later than thirty (30) days after obtaining written verification from the
14 Riverside County Building and Safety Department that the bingo operation
15 complies with Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457 and 787.”

16 **Section 10.** Section 7 of Ordinance No. 558 is amended to read as follows:

17 “Section 7. APPLICATION FEE. A separate application and fee is required for
18 each property location where a bingo game will be conducted.

19 a. The application fee for a bingo license shall be fifty dollars (\$50) and shall
20 accompany the filing of each application.

21 b. An additional fee of ninety (\$90) for law enforcement and public safety costs
22 incurred by the county that are directly related to bingo activities shall accompany
23 the filing of each application.”

24 **Section 11.** Subsection a. of Section 8 of Ordinance No. 558 is amended to read as
25 follows:

26 “a. A bingo license shall expire twelve (12) months after the date of issuance.”

27 **Section 12.** Subsection a. of Section 11 of Ordinance No. 558 is amended to read as
28 follows:

1 “a. Any approval granted pursuant to this ordinance shall be subject to the
2 conditions contained in Penal Code section 326.5 and each licensee shall comply
3 with all applicable state and local laws and regulations.”

4 **Section 13.** Subsection b. of Section 11 of Ordinance No. 558 is amended to read as
5 follows:

6 “b. The licensed qualified organization is responsible for ensuring that the
7 conditions of this ordinance and Penal Code section 326.5 are complied with by the
8 organization and its officers and members. A violation of any one or more of those
9 conditions or provisions shall constitute cause for the revocation of the license to
10 conduct traditional or remote caller bingo games.”

11 **Section 14.** Subsection e. of Section 11 of Ordinance No. 558 is amended to read as
12 follows:

13 “c. No person shall be allowed to participate in bingo games unless the person is
14 physically present at the time and place where the bingo game is being conducted.”

15 **Section 15.** Subsection h. of Section 11 of Ordinance No. 558 is amended to read as
16 follows:

17 “h. The receipts from the bingo games shall only be used for charitable purposes
18 as set forth in Penal Code section 326.5 and this ordinance.”

19 **Section 16.** Subsection k. of Section 11 of Ordinance No. 558 is amended to read as
20 follows:

21 “k. The total value of prizes available to be awarded during the conduct of any
22 bingo game shall not exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) in cash or kind, or both,
23 for each separate game which is held.”

24 **Section 17.** Subsection m. of Section 11 of Ordinance No. 558 is repealed in its entirety.

25 **Section 18.** Subsection a. of Section 15 of Ordinance No. 558 is amended to read as
26 follows:

27 “a. It is a misdemeanor for any person to receive or pay a profit, wage, or salary
28 from any remote caller bingo game. A violation of this subdivision shall be

1 punishable by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars, which fine is deposited in
2 the general fund of the county pursuant to section 326.5(c) of the Penal Code.”

3 **Section 19.** Subsection (1) of Subsection a. of Section 15 of Ordinance No. 558 is
4 repealed in its entirety.

5 **Section 20.** Subsection c. of Section 15 of Ordinance No. 558 is amended to read as
6 follows:

7 “c. Any infraction violation of this ordinance may be enforced by the
8 administrative citation procedure set forth in Riverside County Ordinance No. 725.”

9 **Section 21** Section 17 of Ordinance No. 558 is repealed in its entirety.


10 **Section 22. Severability**

11 Should any fee herein established by held to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable, such determination shall
12 not affect the validity of all remaining fee provisions.

13 **Section 23. Effective Date**

14 This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.




