

BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:

The Riverside County Citrus Pest Control District No. 2 was established under the California Food and Agricultural Code to coordinate and implement pest management programs for the suppression of invasive citrus pests, including California Red Scale and the Asian Citrus Psyllid, within the Coachella Valley.

Mark McBroom currently serves as Operations Manager for Bloom to Box Crop Care, where he oversees citrus production and integrated pest management programs across multiple ranches in the eastern Coachella Valley. He has been an active participant in District programs, including the Area-Wide Treatment and Beneficial Release Initiatives, and brings over a decade of technical and field-based experience.
