

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the Fair Housing Council of Riverside County, Inc. (\$3,000.00) will support the 2026 Annual Housing Conference designed to address housing issues affecting residents throughout Riverside County. The event promotes inclusive, affordable, and sustainable housing solutions while fostering collaboration among local leaders, advocates, and residents to advance fair housing practices.
2. The donation to Friends of the Inland Empire (\$2,500.00) will support the Adopt-A-Senior Project in partnership with the Eddie D. Smith Senior Center in Jurupa Valley. The project provides 75 care packages containing winter hats, gloves, scarves, socks, personal hygiene items, food boxes, and healthy non-perishable snacks for seniors with the greatest need, enhancing well-being and quality of life for seniors.
3. The donation to Thrifting 4 Gifting (\$2,000.00) will support the organization's "5 Points" Program, which partners with the Lake Elsinore Unified School District to provide food-only gift cards to families in need. The program promotes food security and stability for students and their households throughout the school community.
4. The donation to American Legion Auxiliary Unit 328 (\$3,000.00) will support several community projects including the distribution of school supplies to over 100 students in the Corona-Norco Unified School District, assistance to Norco families in need during the Christmas season, and participation in the Annual Girls State Program where the Post sponsors 1-3 delegates.
5. The donation to Santiago High School (\$5,000.00) will support the girls' softball program by providing fencing for the softball field. The improvement enhances safety, accessibility, and the continued development of female athletic programs on campus.
