

**BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **MALHY Community Outreach Protective Services, Inc.**- \$2,500- The funding will be used to support the Mental Health Awareness Program, which provides mental health awareness materials, workshops, and counseling to survivors of human trafficking.
2. **Brighton Hill Academy Sports and Learning Center** - \$3,000- The funds will be used to provide scholarships for low-income students to participate in the program and to purchase essential sports equipment for participants to utilize while in the program.
3. **Compassion Community Outreach Inc.** - \$2,500- The funding will be used to provide groceries to housebound seniors.
4. **Fair Housing Council of Riverside County, Inc.** - \$2,000- This funding will be used to support the 2026 Housing Conference, an event that provides residents with government resources and educational materials related to housing programs.
5. **Stanta Rosa Plateau Foundation, Inc.** - \$10,000- This funding will be used to support the PEPE program, which provides environmental protection education to students in grades 3–12.
6. **Wildomar Community and Parks Foundation, Inc.** - \$1,000- This funding will be used to support the Wildomar Senior Fire Safety and Brush Clearance Program, which reduces fire risk by assisting senior homeowners with yard cleanup.
