

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The Coachella Valley Filipino Festival is a free, community event fiscally sponsored by the Palm Springs Cultural Center which is open to all members of the public with the intention of celebrating Filipino art, food, and culture, and uplifting important historic contributions to this region made by Filipino-Americans. The event was held at the Downtown Palm Springs Park on Saturday November 22, 2025 from 11am to 6pm. CID funds will be used to support the artist and performers who will be part of the cultural and entertainment program.
2. The Regional Access Project (RAP) Foundation will be a fiscal sponsor to support an appreciation event for the Riverside County Animal Campus outdoor staff. The celebration will honor the Animal Campus outdoor workers who routinely encounter challenging field conditions. CID funds will be used towards expenses of the celebration.
3. The Regional Access Project (RAP) Foundation has blazed a path of innovation for regional non-profits, focusing on meeting unmet needs while emphasizing the importance of organizations realizing and maintaining sustainability. RAP intends to identify non-profits in Blythe and work one-on-one to support them by delivering educational services that will help achieve their missions. CID funds will be used to provide technical assistance with a clear focus to build resilient and high-impact nonprofits in the Fourth District.
4. The Riverside County Foundation on Aging distributes grocery market gift cards to seniors in need during the holiday season. CID funds will be used to purchase gift cards that will be distributed to seniors throughout the 4th District.
5. The Riverside County Office on Aging is the County department responsible for developing a network of resources to offer support for vulnerable older adults, people with disabilities, and their caregivers. Office on Aging is hosting a turkey giveaway for the holiday season to give away to the most vulnerable clients in need that are served at the Blythe Community Center. CID funds will be used to purchase turkeys.
