BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Coachella Valley Violent Crime Gang Task Force (CVVCGTF) purchased a 2011 Ford Econoline Van in 2012. The CVVCGTF was unable to register the van, so participating cities took turns registering the van and insuring it. In 2025, the Executive Board voted and approved the van to be registered under the Riverside County Sheriff's Office. The City of Desert Hot Springs signed over title and wrote a letter of no interest in the van. This donation is intended for the sole use of the CVVCGTF in conjunction with other Gang Task Force personnel. This donation will continue to support the CVVCGTF with operations and office use for current and future teams.

Assets are identified as:

2011 Ford E350 Van – VIN 1FBNE3BL9BDB11663

Upon approval, the Ford E350 Van will be registered with the California Department of Motor Vehicles and will be issued a County Asset Tag for tracking purposes.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Accepting the donation of the 2011 Ford Econoline Van will benefit the CVVCGTF by providing additional vehicles to use for operations within the County. The Riverside County Sheriff's Office will be responsible for the maintenance and repair of the vehicle.
