2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Van Buren Boulevard Resurfacing Project, in the Community of Woodcrest;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 7, 2026, at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface the full width of approximately 1-mile segment of Van Buren Boulevard from Capella Street to Washington Street in the Community of Woodcrest in Riverside County.

At the project limits, Van Buren Boulevard is a four-lane facility that travels in the East-West direction with a road width that varies between 63 feet and 88 feet wide with segments of striped and raised median, paved and dirt shoulders, asphalt concrete dike and concrete curb and gutter, and is currently classified as an urban arterial highway in the circulation element of the County of Riverside General Plan. The areas in the immediate vicinity mainly consist of hilly open spaces areas, residential areas with single family dwellings, commercial areas, and vacant parcels areas.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed resurfacing project consists of grinding down a portion of the existing asphalt concrete pavement, sealing existing cracks, and overlaying with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). Additionally, the treatment for the approach portions of various intersecting streets will consist of removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing new HMA pavement.

Additional improvements include reconstruction of asphalt concrete dike, reconstruction of asphalt concrete driveways, construction of concrete sidewalk, reconstruction of concrete curb and gutter, cross gutters, spandrels and of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant concrete access ramps. Project construction will include updating the traffic signal at the intersection of Van Buren Boulevard and King Avenue to video camera detection system; safety features include installation of new painted traffic striping, retroreflective pavement markers, thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement markings, roadside signs, and other associated work.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Alternative Bid Schedule 1: Charter Communications Facility Adjustments

The adjustment of the facilities owned by Charter Communications is also included in the bid package as an alternative bid schedule. If Charter Communications approves the award of the alternative bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by Charter Communications through reimbursement letter Agreement that will be executed by the Director of Transportation. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Environmental Findings

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the Van Buren Boulevard resurfacing project does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new HMA for the approximate 1-mile segment of Van Buren Boulevard, from Capella Street to Washington Street, in the Community of Woodcrest to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in spring 2026. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two and a half months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$3,358,774. The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 and Charter Communications funds.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

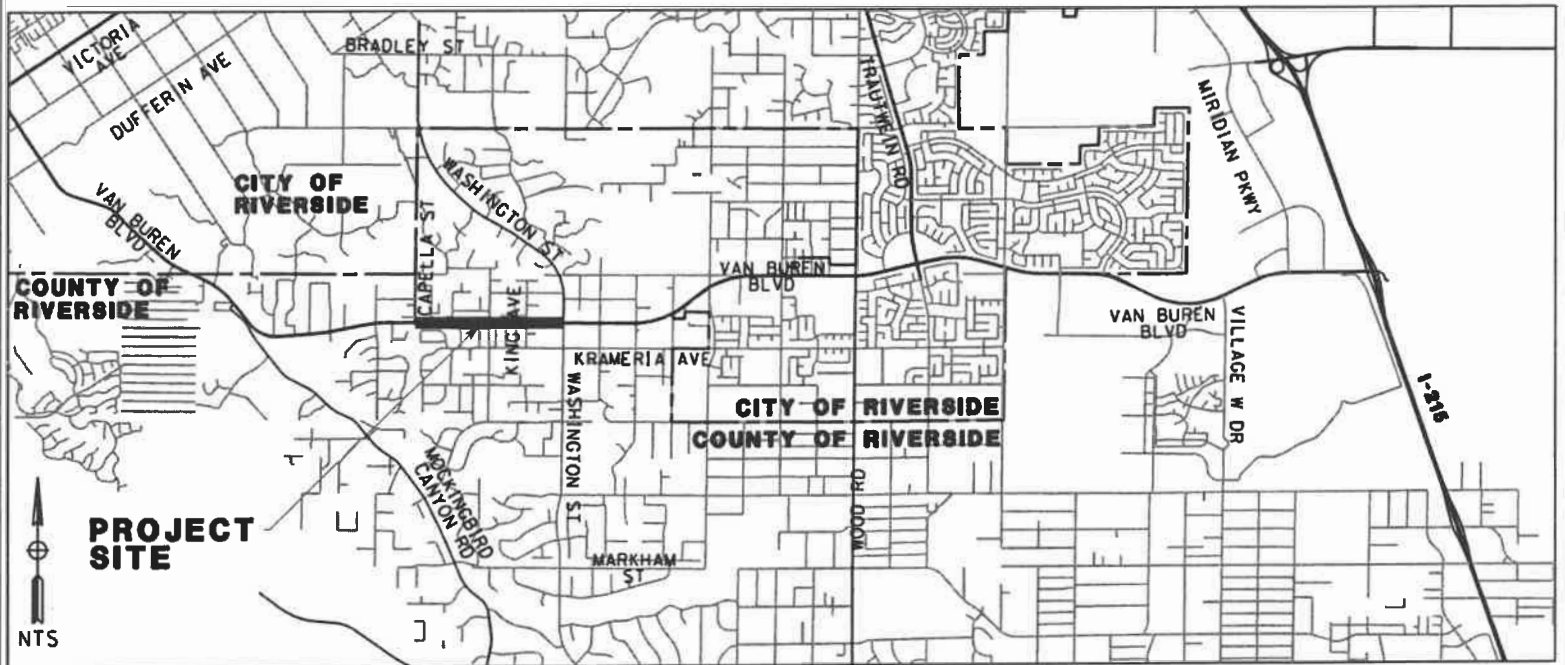

Pursuant to Labor Code section 1771.1, any Contractor bidding, or subcontractor to be listed on a bid proposal subject to Public Contract Code section 4104, shall not be qualified to bid after March 1, 2015, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public works pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. No Contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract or perform work on any contract for public work, after April 1, 2015, without proof of current registration with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 to perform public works.
