



**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The College of the Desert Foundation provides short- and long-term scholarships, textbooks, upgrades to buildings, technology, and equipment, faculty positions and other programs with the goal of removing financial barriers to student's education and enhancing academic and extracurricular programs that enrich their education. The State of the College provides an opportunity for the President to share with the community some of the outstanding achievements and to chart a path for the future by outlining priorities for the coming year and beyond. Funds raised from the event support the Fund for Student Success. CID funds will be used to support the College of the Desert Foundation.
  
2. The Riverside County Office on Aging (RCOoA) is the County department responsible for developing a network of resources to offer support for vulnerable older adults, persons with disabilities, and their caregivers. Funding through RCOoA is restricted to home delivered meals (HDM) or congregate meals and must meet CDA health and safety guidelines. CID funds will be used to purchase blenders to make healthy fruit juices, large-serving coffee dispenser, karaoke machine, and salt-free seasoning for seniors served at Doris Morgan Community Center in Blythe.
