5. Approve the project's proposed budget as shown in Attachment "A".



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated August 26, 2025 (Agenda Item 3.69), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Cajalco Road, Cajalco Expressway, and Ramona Expressway Resurfacing Projects in the Community of Mead Valley.

The project consists of resurfacing an approximately 0.65-mile segment of Cajalco Road, a 0.29-mile segment of Cajalco Expressway, and a 0.26-mile segment of Ramona Expressway in the Community of Mead Valley of Riverside County.

The road segments included are as follows:

Road	From	To
Cajalco Road	200-feet west of Wood Road	50-feet east of Carpinus Drive
Cajalco Expressway	90-feet west of Harvill Avenue	I-215 south-bound ramps
Ramona Expressway	I-215 south-bound ramps	200-feet east of Nevada Road

The projects were combined to bid as one project in order to gain cost efficiencies by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures and to seek more favorable proposed costs associated with larger bid quantities.

The areas in the immediate vicinity of Cajalco Road include residential areas with single family dwellings and vacant parcels areas. The areas in the immediate vicinity of Ramona Expressway and Cajalco Expressway include business centers and commercial properties.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Mainly, the Cajalco Road, Cajalco Expressway, and Ramona Expressway Resurfacing Projects consist of cold planing existing asphalt concrete pavement, sealing existing cracks, and overlaying with

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Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). Additionally, sections of each road segment will require removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing HMA.

Additional improvements include construction of asphalt concrete driveways, construction of asphalt concrete dike, placement of safety edge to protect the outside edge of pavement and shoulder backing, and construction of new asphalt concrete overside drains. Safety features include placing of traffic stripes, thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement marking, roadside signs, and other associated work.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award.

The addendum did not increase nor decrease the engineer's cost estimate. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

The Contract includes the following schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule:	Cajalco Road, Cajalco Expressway, Ramona Expressway Resurfacing
Alternate Bid Schedule 1:	Western Municipal Water District (WMWD) Facilities Adjustment

WMWD has accepted the bid prices proposed by Romero General Construction for Alternative Bid Schedule 1, that includes adjustments of two (2) sewer manholes located on Cajalco Road and the cost for the work will be reimbursed by WMWD through a reimbursement letter Agreement that will be executed by the Director of Transportation. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The contractor, Romero General Construction, is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the Contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the contract documents.

Project Nos. D2-0098 – Cajalco Road Resurfacing,
D4-0059 – Cajalco Expressway Resurfacing, and
D4-0060 – Ramona Expressway Resurfacing

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of these projects is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for approximate 1.2-mile of combined segments of Cajalco Road, Cajalco Expressway, and Ramona Expressway in the Community of Mead Valley to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

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The work is scheduled to begin in winter 2025/2026. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two and a half months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2025/2026 and will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 and Western Municipal Water District Fund.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A total of eight bids were received on Wednesday September 24, 2025, ranging from \$2,570,436 to \$2,747,051. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The low bidder, Romero General Construction, submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$2,570,436 which is \$309,502 (10.75%) below the engineer's cost estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the Contract to Romero General Construction in the amount of \$2,570,436.

Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and Romero General Construction Corp. hereafter called "Contractor".

W I T N E S S E T H

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, Cajalco Road, Cajalco Expressway, Ramona Expressway Resurfacing, Cajalco Road: 200-Foot West of Wood Road to 50-Foot East of Carpinus Drive, Cajalco Expressway: 90-Foot West of Harvill Avenue to I-215 SB Ramps, Ramona Expressway: I-215 SB Ramps to 200-Foot East of Nevada Road, Community of Mead Valley, Project No. D2-0098, D4-0059, D4-0060, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of **2018** as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda **(One)**, (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.





**ESCROW AGREEMENT FOR
SECURITY DEPOSITS IN LIEU OF RETENTION**

Escrow No. 4001009697

This Escrow Agreement is made and entered into by and between County of Riverside, whose address is 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501, hereinafter called "Owner," Romero General Construction Corp, whose address is 2150 N. Centre City Parkway, Suite I, Escondido, CA 92026, hereinafter called "Contractor," and Endeavor Bank, whose address is 9400 Grossmont Summit Dr. Suite 201 La Mesa, CA 91941, hereinafter called "Escrow Agent."

For the consideration hereinafter set forth, the Owner, Contractor, and Escrow Agent agree as follows:

- (1) Pursuant to Section 22300 of the Public Contract Code of the State of California, Contractor has the option to deposit securities with Escrow Agent as a substitute for retention earnings required to be withheld by Owner pursuant to the Construction Contract entered into between the Owner and Contractor for Cajalco Road, Cajalco Expressway, Ramona Expressway Resurfacing, Cajalco Road: 200-Foot West of Wood Road to 50-Foot East of Carpinus Drive, Cajalco Expressway: 90-Foot West of Harvill Avenue to I-215 SB Ramps, Ramona Expressway: I-215 SB Ramps to 200-Foot East of Nevada Road, Community of Mead Valley, Project No. D2-0098, D4-0059, D4-0060, Contract No. 25-10-001, in the amount of \$2,570,435.85 (Two million, five hundred seventy thousand, four hundred thirty-five dollars and eighty-five cents) dated December 16, 2025 (hereinafter referred to as the "Contract"). Alternatively, on written request of the Contractor, the Owner shall make payments of the retention earnings directly to the Escrow Agent. When the Contractor deposits the securities as a substitute for Contract earnings, the Escrow Agent shall notify the Owner within 10 days of the deposit. The market value of the securities at the time of the substitution shall be at least equal to the cash amount then required to be withheld as retention under the terms of the Contract between the Owner and Contractor. Securities shall be held in the name of County of Riverside Transportation Department, and shall designate the Contractor as the beneficial owner.
- (2) The Owner shall make progress payments to the Contractor for those funds which otherwise would be withheld

from progress payments pursuant to the Contract provisions, provided that the Escrow Agent holds securities in the form and amount specified above.

- (3) When the Owner makes payment of retentions earned directly to the Escrow Agent, the Escrow Agent shall hold them for the benefit of the Contractor until the time that the escrow created under this Contract is terminated. The Contractor may direct the investment of the payments into securities. All terms and conditions of this agreement and the rights and responsibilities of the parties shall be equally applicable and binding when the Owner pays the Escrow Agent directly.
- (4) Contractor shall be responsible for paying all fees for the expenses incurred by Escrow Agent in administering the Escrow Account and all expenses of the Owner. These expenses and payment terms shall be determined by the Owner, Contractor, and Escrow Agent.
- (5) The interest earned on the securities or the money market accounts held in escrow and all interest earned on that interest shall be for the sole account of Contractor and shall be subject to withdrawal by Contractor at any time and from time to time without notice to the Owner.
- (6) Contractor shall have the right to withdraw all or any part of the principal in the Escrow Account only by written notice to Escrow Agent accompanied by written authorization from the Owner to the Escrow Agent that Owner consents to the withdrawal of the amount sought to be withdrawn by Contractor.
- (7) The Owner shall have a right to draw upon the securities in the event of default by the Contractor. Upon seven days' written notice to the Escrow Agent from the owner of the default, the Escrow Agent shall immediately convert the securities to cash and shall distribute the cash as instructed by the Owner.
- (8) Upon receipt of written notification from the Owner certifying that the Contract is final and complete, and that the Contractor has complied with all requirements and procedures applicable to the Contract, Escrow Agent shall release to Contractor all securities and interest on deposit less escrow fees and charges of the Escrow Account. The escrow shall be closed immediately upon disbursement of all moneys and securities on deposit and payments of fees and charges.
- (9) Escrow Agent shall rely on the written notifications from the Owner and the Contractor pursuant to Sections (5) to (8), inclusive, of this Agreement and the Owner and Contractor shall hold Escrow Agent harmless from Escrow Agent's release and disbursement of the securities and interest as set forth above.



Item 2: Hot Mix Asphalt. Refer to Section 39-2, Hot Mix Asphalt, on pages 34 through 52 of the Special Provisions.

- Delete Section 39-2, Hot Mix Asphalt, and replace it with the following:

Replace Section 39-2, HOT MIX ASPHALT, with the following:

39-2.01 Hot Mix Asphalt

This work includes producing and placing **Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Type A**. Comply with the specifications for HMA under Section 39, "Asphalt Concrete" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions. All other requirements of Section 39 shall apply unless otherwise modified or replaced in these Special Provisions.

The type of hot mix asphalt will be shown on the plans or specified in the Special Provisions.

39-2.01(1a) Material

39-2.01(1a.1) Prime Coat

Liquid asphalt for prime coat shall be Grade SC-70. Prime coat shall be applied only to those areas designated by the Engineer. The application rate shall be 0.20 gallon per square yard of surface covered. The exact rate and number of applications will be determined by the Engineer.

39-2.01(1a.2) Tack Coat

Asphaltic emulsion for paint binder (tack coat) shall conform to the provisions in Section 94, "Asphaltic Emulsion" of the Standard Specifications for the rapid-setting or slow-setting type and grade approved by the Engineer. Grade SS1h shall be used if not otherwise specified. Tack coat shall be applied to all vertical surfaces of existing pavement, curbs, gutters, and construction joints in the surfacing against which additional material is to be placed, to a pavement to be surfaced, and to other surfaces designated in the Special Provisions. The application rate shall be from 0.02 to 0.10 gallon per square yard of surface covered. The exact rate and number of applications will be determined by the Engineer. Application of tack coat shall meet the provisions in Section 39-2.01C(3)(f) of the Standard Specifications.

39-2.01(1a.3) Asphalt Binder

Performance grade (PG) asphalt binder shall conform to the provisions of Section 92, "Asphalt Binders" of the Standard Specifications.

The Contractor shall furnish asphalt in conformance with the State of California Department of Transportation's "Certification Program for Suppliers of Asphalt." The Department maintains the program requirements, procedures, and a list of approved suppliers at the State of California Department of Transportation's METS web site.

The grade for asphalt binder shall be **PG 64-28M**. If reclaimed asphalt pavement (RAP) is used, Section 39-2.01(1a.5) shall apply.

39-2.01(1a.4) Aggregate

Aggregate shall be clean and free from decomposed materials, organic material, and other deleterious substances.

The aggregate gradation for Type A HMA shall be within the target value (TV) limits for the specified sieve sizes shown in Section 39-2.02B(4)(b) of the Standard Specifications.

The aggregate quality shall conform to the requirements of Section 39-2.02B(4)(a) of the Standard Specifications prior to the addition of asphalt binder.

39-2.01(1a.5) Reclaimed Asphalt Pavement

The use of reclaimed asphalt pavement (RAP) in Type A HMA production may be substituted in a quantity up to 10 percent of the aggregate blend in the surface course (upper layer) and up to 25 percent in the base course (lower layer).

For RAP substitution of 15 percent or less, the grade of the virgin binder shall be the specified grade of asphalt binder for Type A HMA. For RAP substitution greater than 15 percent and not exceeding 25 percent, the grade of the virgin binder shall be the specified grade of asphalt binder for Type A HMA with the upper and lower temperature classification reduced by 6 degrees C.

RAP stockpile used in the mix design shall be sampled and tested under CT 384. The average uncorrected binder content determined in accordance with AASHTO T 308 shall be reported on the mix design form. The sampling and testing frequency shall be performed at a minimum frequency of 1 sample per 1000 tons under CT 384 to determine the uncorrected binder content under AASHTO T 308. Each sample shall consist of three tests, and the uncorrected binder content shall be the average of the three tests. The uncorrected binder content of each sample must be within ± 2.00 percent of the average uncorrected binder content reported on the mix design form.

The combined RAP sample when tested under AASHTO T 209 must be within ± 0.06 percent of the average maximum specific gravity reported on the mix design form.

During Type A HMA production, RAP shall be sampled and tested for aggregate gradation at least once a day under CT 384 and for moisture content at least once a day.

39-2.01(1a.6) Miscellaneous Areas and Dikes

Miscellaneous areas and dikes shall conform to the provisions of Section 39-2.01B(11) of the Standard Specifications.

The asphalt binder for miscellaneous areas shall be PG 64-10.

The aggregate gradation for miscellaneous areas shall be 3/4-inch or 1/2-inch Type A HMA conforming to the grading and quality requirements of Section 39-2.02B(4)(b) and Section 39-2.02B(4)(a), respectively. RAP will not be used in miscellaneous areas.

The asphalt binder for dike mix shall be PG 70-10.

Aggregate for dike mix shall be clean and free from deleterious substances. The aggregate gradation shall be within the target value (TV) limits for the specified sieve sizes shown in the following tables. RAP will not be used in dike mix.

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39-2.01(1b) Mix Design

The mix design for Type A HMA shall conform to the provisions of Section 39-2.02B(2) of the Standard Specifications and the following table:

The Contractor shall submit records of aggregate quality and mix design data. Test data or mix design documentation shall be dated within 24 months of the submittal date or from the last test performed.

The Contractor shall submit the mix design using the “*COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, CONTRACTOR JOB MIX FORMULA PROPOSAL*” form to present the JMF. Formats other than the referenced form will not be accepted.

For RAP substitution of 15 percent or less, RAP shall be within ±3 of RAP percentage shown on the Contractor Job Mix Formula Proposal form without exceeding 15 percent. Fractionation is not required.

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Cajalco Expressway: 90-Feet West of Harvill Avenue to I-215 SB Ramps
Ramona Expressway: I-215 SB Ramps to 200-Feet East of Nevada Road
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For RAP substitution of greater than 15 percent, RAP shall be within ± 3 of RAP percentage shown on the Contractor Job Mix Formula Proposal form without exceeding 25 percent. RAP stockpiles shall be fractionated into 2 sizes, a coarse fraction RAP retained on 3/8-inch sieve and a fine fraction RAP passing 3/8-inch sieve. The fractionation grading shall meet the requirements shown in the following table:

The final JMF shall be signed and stamped by a Civil Engineer registered in the State of California.

If any adjustment is made to the final JMF, a new mix design will be performed and a new JMF will be submitted.

39-2.01(1c) Certifications

Laboratories testing aggregate and HMA qualities used to prepare the mix design and JMF shall be qualified under the State of California Department of Transportation's Independent Assurance Program.

Before production of HMA, the HMA plant must have a current qualification under the State of California Department of Transportation's Materials Plant Quality Program or utilize weighing and metering devices that comply with California test 109.

39-2.01(1d) Construction

Construction of HMA shall be in conformance with the provisions of Section 39-2.01C, "Construction" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

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Ramona Expressway: I-215 SB Ramps to 200-Feet East of Nevada Road
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39-2.01(1d.1) Lift Thickness

Type A HMA shall comply with the aggregate gradation requirements and shall be spread and compacted in the number of layers of the thicknesses indicated in the following table:

^a Upper layer may contain up to 10 percent RAP in the HMA mix. Bottom and all other lower layers may contain up to 25 percent RAP in the HMA mix.

^b One layer of 0.25 foot for the 3/4 inch containing up to 10 percent may be placed as approved by the Engineer.

39-2.01(1d.2) Sampling

The Contractor or the Contractor's representative shall provide a sampling device in the asphalt feed line connecting the plant storage tanks to the asphalt weighing system or spray bar. The sampling device shall be accessible between 24 and 30 inches above the platform. The Contractor shall provide a receptacle for flushing the sampling device.

The sampling device shall include a valve:

1. With a diameter between 1/2 and 3/4 inches;
2. Manufactured in a manner that a one-quart sample may be taken slowly at any time during plant operations;
3. Maintained in good condition.

The Contractor shall replace failed valves.

In the presence of the Engineer, the Contractor shall take 2 one-quart samples per operating day. The Contractor shall provide round friction top containers with one-quart capacity for storing samples.

The Contractor shall take samples of aggregates, asphalt binder, RAP, and HMA. Aggregates shall be sampled from the combined cold-feed belt or hot bin. RAP shall be sampled from the RAP system. The frequency of sampling shall be in accordance with Section 39-2.01(1d.6c) of these Special Provisions.

39-2.01(1d.3) Control of Materials

All proposed materials for use in HMA shall be furnished in conformance with the provisions of Section 6, "Control of Materials" of the Standard Specifications and this Section. All materials to be used in producing the hot mix asphalt shall be supplied from a single source for each material unless approved by the Engineer. Materials to be used in HMA will be subject to inspection and tests by the Engineer. The Contractor shall furnish without charge sample of materials as may be required.

The Contractor shall furnish the Engineer a list of the Contractor's sources of materials and the locations at which those materials will be available for inspection. The Contractor shall assure that the Engineer has free access or entry at all times to the material or production of the material to be inspected, sampled, and tested. It is understood that the inspections and tests made at any point shall, in no way, be considered as a guaranty of acceptance of the material nor continued acceptance of the material presumed to be similar to that upon which inspections and tests have been made, and that inspection and testing performed by the Engineer shall not relieve the Contractor of responsibility for quality control.

All materials which the Engineer has determined defective or do not conform to the requirements of the plans and specifications will be rejected whether in place or not. Under the provisions of this Section, the Engineer will have authority to cause the removal and replacement of rejected material and to deduct the cost thereof from any moneys due or to become due the Contractor.

39-2.01(1d.4) Utility Covers

Except as otherwise provided herein, the Contractor shall adjust to finish grade any valve covers encountered within the project limits, as required, for those utility valves that are provided with slip cans and are adjustable without the replacement of part or the removal of concrete collars. In cases where the owning utility company insists upon upgrades in the standards, or when additional parts or the removal of concrete collars are required for the adjustment, said adjustment will be the responsibility of the owning utility company.

The Contractor shall lower manholes and valves when and as necessary for the protection of the traveling public during construction and shall coordinate all work on said facilities with the owning utility companies. Final adjustment to grade will be the responsibility of the owning utility company, except as provided herein.

39-2.01(1d.5) Placing HMA

Asphalt paving equipment shall be in conformance with the provisions of Section 39-2.01C(2), "Spreading and Compacting Equipment" of the Standard Specifications. Spreading and Compacting shall be in accordance with this Section and the provisions in Section 39-2.01C, "Construction" of the Standard Specifications.

When placing asphalt concrete to the lines and grades established by the Engineer, the automatic controls shall control the longitudinal grade and transverse slope of the screed. Grade and slope references shall be furnished, installed, and maintained by the Contractor. When directed, the Contractor shall use a ski device with a minimum length of 30 feet. The ski device shall be a rigid one-piece unit and the entire length shall be utilized in activating the sensor.

When placing the initial mat of asphalt concrete on existing pavement, the end of the screed nearest the centerline shall be controlled by a sensor activated by a ski device not less than 30 feet. The end of the screed farthest from centerline shall be controlled by an automatic transverse slope device set to reproduce the cross slope designated by the Engineer, by a sensor activated by a similar ski device or as directed by the Engineer.

When paving contiguously with previously placed mats, the end of the screed adjacent to the previously placed mat shall be controlled by a sensor that responds to the grade of the previously placed mat and will reproduce the grade in the new mat within a 0.12-inch tolerance. The end of the screed farthest from the previously placed mat shall be controlled in the same way it was controlled when placing the initial mat.

Addendum No. 1

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Cajalco Expressway: 90-Feet West of Harvill Avenue to I-215 SB Ramps
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Should the methods and equipment furnished by the Contractor fail to produce a layer of asphalt concrete conforming to the provisions, including straightedge tolerance, of Section 39-2.01C, "Construction" of the Standard Specifications or elsewhere in these Special Provisions, the paving operations shall be discontinued and the Contractor shall modify the equipment or methods, or furnish substitute equipment.

Should the automatic screed controls fail to operate properly during a day's work, the Contractor may manually control the spreading equipment for the remainder of that day. However, the equipment shall be corrected or replaced with alternative automatically controlled equipment conforming to the provisions in this section before starting another day's work.

39-2.01(1d.6) Contractor Quality Control

39-2.01(1d.6a) Quality Control Plan

The contractor shall submit a quality control plan with the proposed HMA type, RAP, and mix design in accordance with Section 39-2.01A(3)(c), "Quality Control Plan" of the Standard Specifications.

39-2.01(1d.6b) HMA Production

The HMA production shall comply with the provisions of Section 39-2.01B(8) of the Standard Specification and the provisions of these Special Provisions.

39-2.01(1d.6c) Quality Control Testing

The Contractor shall perform quality control sampling and testing at the specified frequency for the quality characteristics shown in the following tables:

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39-2.01(1d.6d) Density Cores

The Contractor shall take 4- or 6-inch diameter density cores from each 500 tons of HMA produced.

The location of the density cores shall be randomly selected by the Engineer and shall be performed in the Engineer's presence. Density holes shall be backfilled and compacted with material approved by the Engineer. Density cores shall be marked with the density core's location and layer number and shall be placed in a protective container. If a density core is damaged, it shall be replaced and re-cored within 1 foot longitudinally from the original density core.

Density cores shall be taken from the final layer and cored through the entire pavement thickness shown.

39-2.01(1d.6e) Compaction

Contractor shall determine the in-place density and relative compaction of HMA pavement in accordance with the procedures of California Test 375. The Contractor shall use California Test 308, Method A, in determining in-place density of each density core instead of using the nuclear gauge in Part 4, "Determining In-Place Density by the Nuclear Density Device." Where inertial profiler is required, the profiling operation shall conform to California Test 387 and the smoothness requirements in Section 36-3. Asphalt concrete pavement profiled shall conform to the following surface requirements:

1. Surface shall have no areas of localized roughness with an International Roughness Index (IRI) greater than 160 in/mi.
2. Surface shall comply with the Mean Roughness Index requirements shown in the following table for a 0.1 mile section:

Areas of the asphalt concrete pavement surface that do not meet the specified surface tolerances shall be corrected by grinding. When an inertial profiler is used, a corrective grinding plan shall be submitted prior to performing corrective grinding for areas of localized roughness or areas exceeding the specified thresholds for the Mean Roughness Index. For pavement smoothness measured with a straightedge, a list of the areas requiring smoothness correction shall be submitted prior to performing corrective grinding. Areas which have been subjected to grinding and represent more than 25 percent of the total pavement surface profiled shall receive a slurry seal. Areas subjected to grinding but represent 25 percent or less of the total pavement surface profiled shall receive a fog seal. Ground areas which cannot be brought into specified tolerance by abrasive grinding shall be corrected by either (1) removal and replacement or (2) placing an overlay of asphalt concrete.

Ground areas shall be neat rectangular areas of uniform surface appearance and shall receive the respective seal coat prior to acceptance of the work. The limit of the respective seal (length and width) shall be directed by the Engineer.

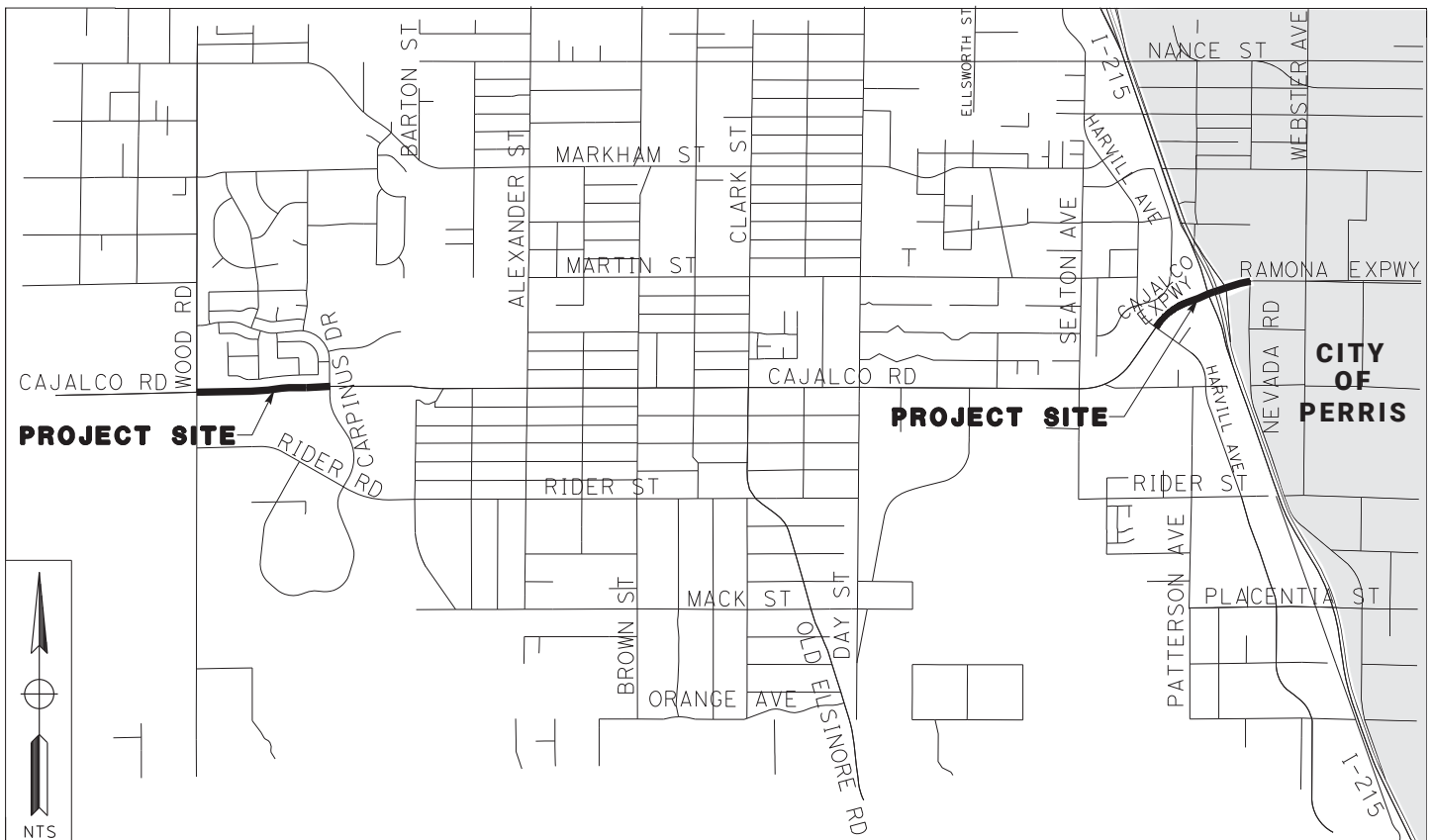
