Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 14, 2026, at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse for posting within five (5) working days.



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface an approximate 1.2-mile segment of Buck Road/Warren Road between the intersection of Buck Road/Rancho California Road and Warren Road/Borel Road in the communities of Rancho California and French Valley.

By Minute Order dated May 7, 2024 (agenda item 3.24), the Board of Supervisors approved and authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Buck Road – Warren Road Resurfacing Project. On the scheduled bids due date of Wednesday, May 29, 2024, six bids for the project were received in the office of the Director of Transportation. By Minute Order dated August 27, 2024 (agenda item 3.94), the Board of Supervisors accepted the low bid and awarded the contract to Vance Corporation of Beaumont, California in the amount of \$1,528,013.

After award of contract, the County of Riverside Transportation Department was informed of an upcoming Temecula Wine Country Sewer Infrastructure project by Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD). In early 2025, EMWD began installing new sewer lines in Temecula Valley Wine Country region which impacted the Transportation Department’s resurfacing project on Buck and Warren Road. To avoid potential conflicts between the projects, Transportation Department re-evaluated the project, and decided to let EMWD proceed with installation of sewer lines, canceled the construction contract with Vance Corporation, and rebid the project after the construction of EMWD’s sewer infrastructure project.

Buck Road – Warren Road is a two-lane facility with a road width of 26 feet and is currently classified as mountain arterial road in the circulation element of the County of Riverside General Plan. Buck Road becomes Warren Road at the intersection with East Benton Road. The areas in the immediate vicinity include wineries and open fields.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed resurfacing project consists of grinding in place (pulverize) the existing Asphalt Concrete (AC)

pavement, performing moisture conditioning, mixing and recompacting grindings with existing native material, and paving the new base with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA).

Additional improvements include construction of asphalt concrete dike, the construction of asphalt concrete driveways, the construction of runoff infiltration areas adjacent to the roadway for the removal of pollutants in stormwater, the placement of safety edge and shoulder backing to protect the outside edge of pavement, safety features include placing thermoplastic pavement markings, roadside signs, and other associated work.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule 1:	Buck Road – Warren Road Resurfacing Project
Alternative Bid Schedule 1:	Frontier Manhole Adjustments
Alternative Bid Schedule 2:	Eastern Municipal Water District Manhole Adjustments

The adjustment of the facilities owned by Frontier and EMWD are also included in the bid package as alternative bid schedules 1 and 2. If Frontier and EMWD approve the award of their respective alternative bid schedules, as bid by the apparent low bidder, then the cost for the work will be funded by the utility owners through reimbursement letter Agreement that will be executed by the Director of Transportation. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

**Environmental Findings**

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the Buck Road – Warren Road resurfacing project does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt concrete for the approximate 1.2-mile segment of Buck Road – Warren Road in the Communities of Rancho California and French Valley to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in late spring 2026. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,800,981. The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1, Frontier, and Eastern Municipal Water District funds.

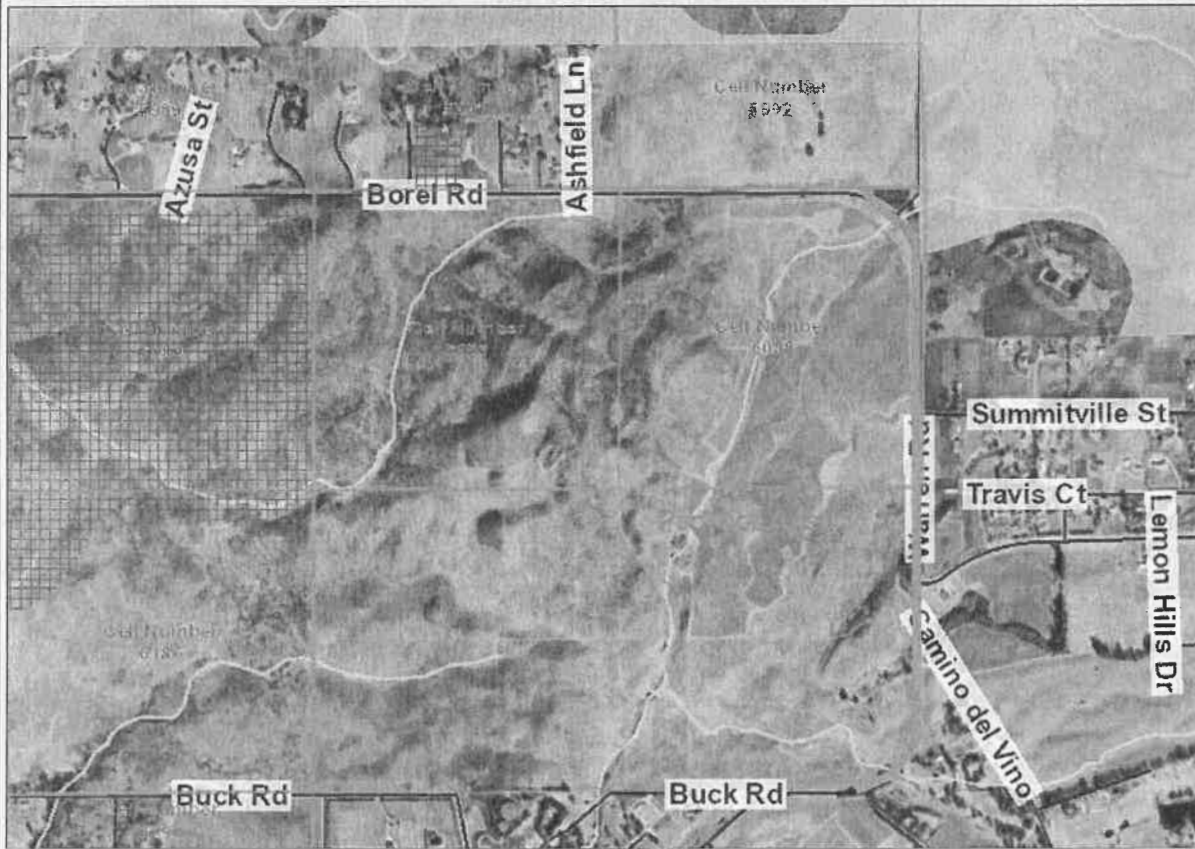

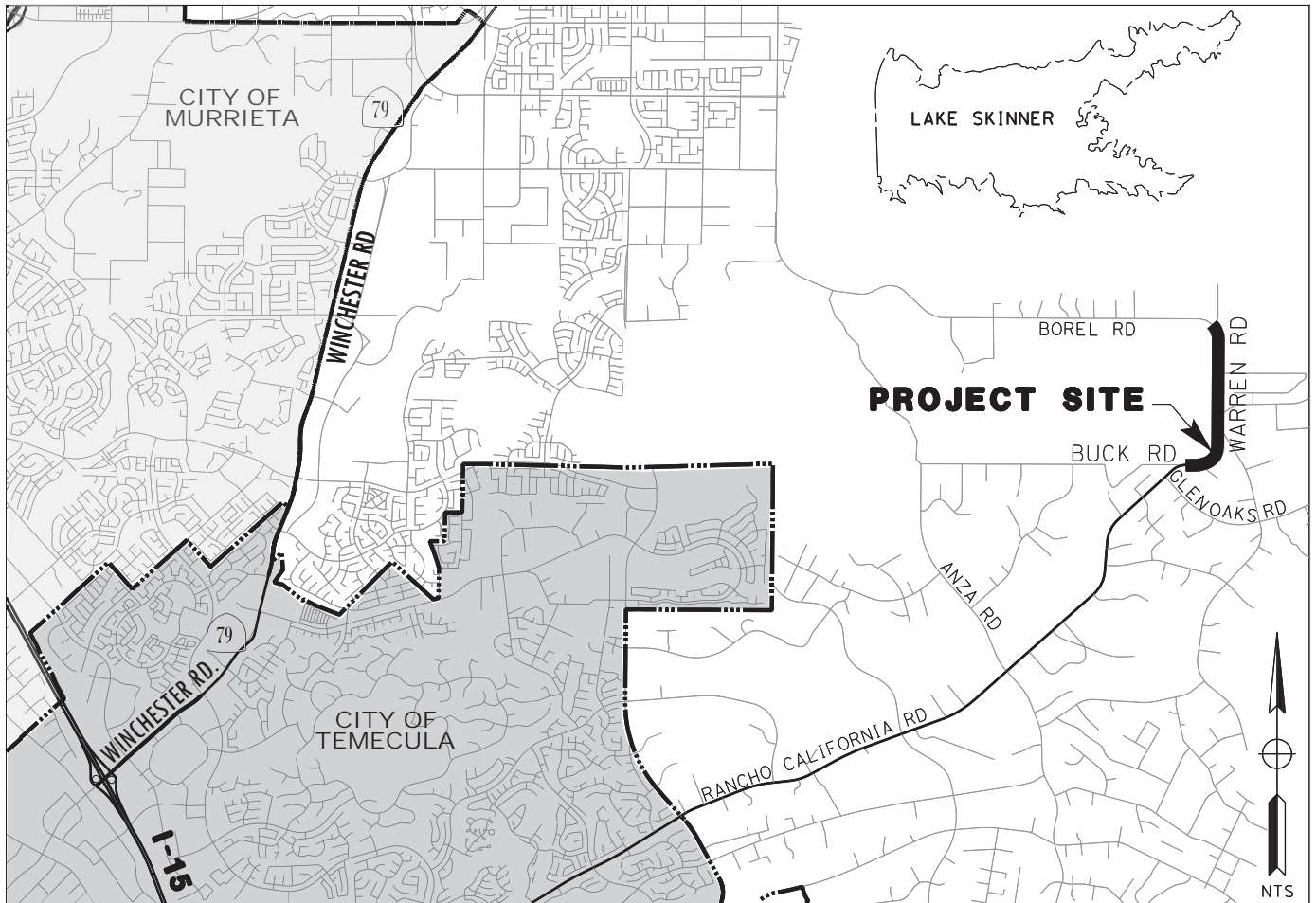
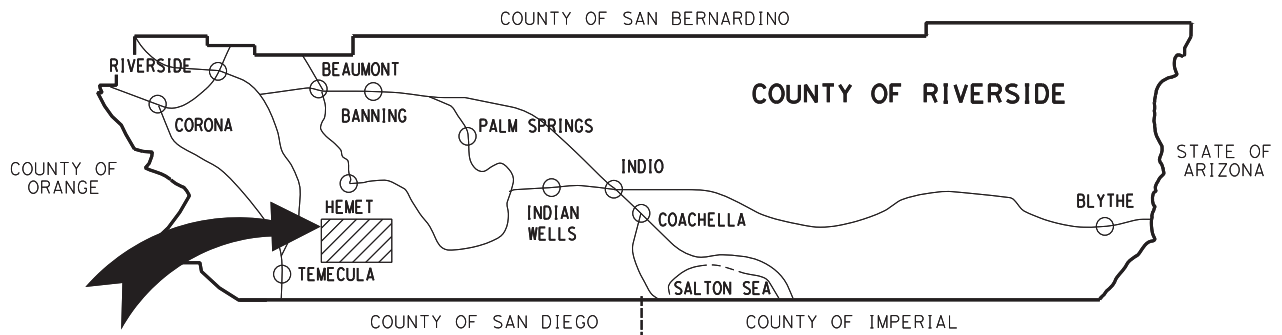
