

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Bridge Preventive Maintenance Program (BPMP) project is provided to rehabilitate and perform preventive maintenance activities on various County bridges over waterways, highways, or railroads, to keep bridges in good condition, and to reduce the need for more costly rehabilitation, reconstruction, or replacement of bridges.

This project includes eighteen bridges located within the communities of Desert Center, Oasis, Thermal, Thousand Palms, San Timoteo Canyon, Mead Valley, Murrieta Hot Springs, El Cerrito, and areas near the Cities of Palm Desert, San Jacinto, Riverside and Corona. The specific bridges are listed in "Attachment 1".

The BPMP project includes replacing deteriorated expansion joint seals, sealing concrete bridge decks to reduce the amount of water infiltrating the bridge, applying protective concrete deck overlays, repairing of significant concrete spalls that have structural impacts on the longevity of the bridge, repairing and strengthening of steel components, replacement or supplementation of timber structural elements, and minor repairs and other measures to slow the rate of deterioration of bridge elements. Additional improvements include installation of traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, and other associated work.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

Base Bid: Bridge Preventive Maintenance Program

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

**Environmental Findings**

**SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE,  
STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the Bridge Preventive Maintenance Program project does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The BPMP project will help to keep various County bridges in good condition and will extend the life of the bridges thereby postponing more costly pavement rehabilitation, reconstruction, or replacement.

The work is scheduled to begin in spring 2026. The work will be phased to keep the bridge open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately ten months to complete.

**SUPPLEMENTAL:**

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$ 3,810,423. The BPMP work will be mainly funded with federal funds - Highway Bridge Program funds and partially funded with local funds - Gas Tax / HUTA funds.

No General Funds will be used on this project.

The bridge preventative maintenance work is divided into three categories as follows:

Four bridges are in this category.

- Category B: Preventative maintenance work that requires no equipment or ground disturbance in the channel or below the bridge. 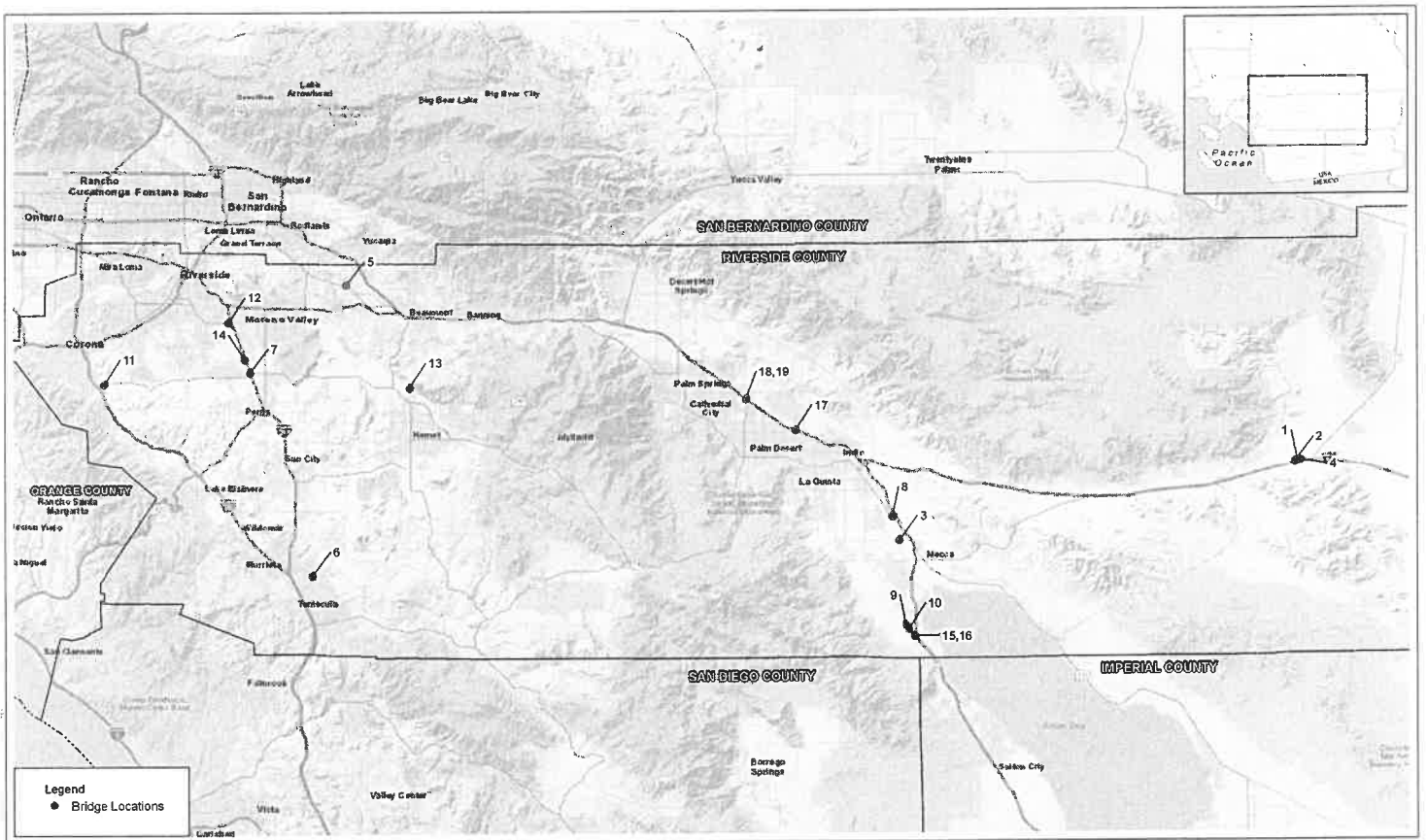

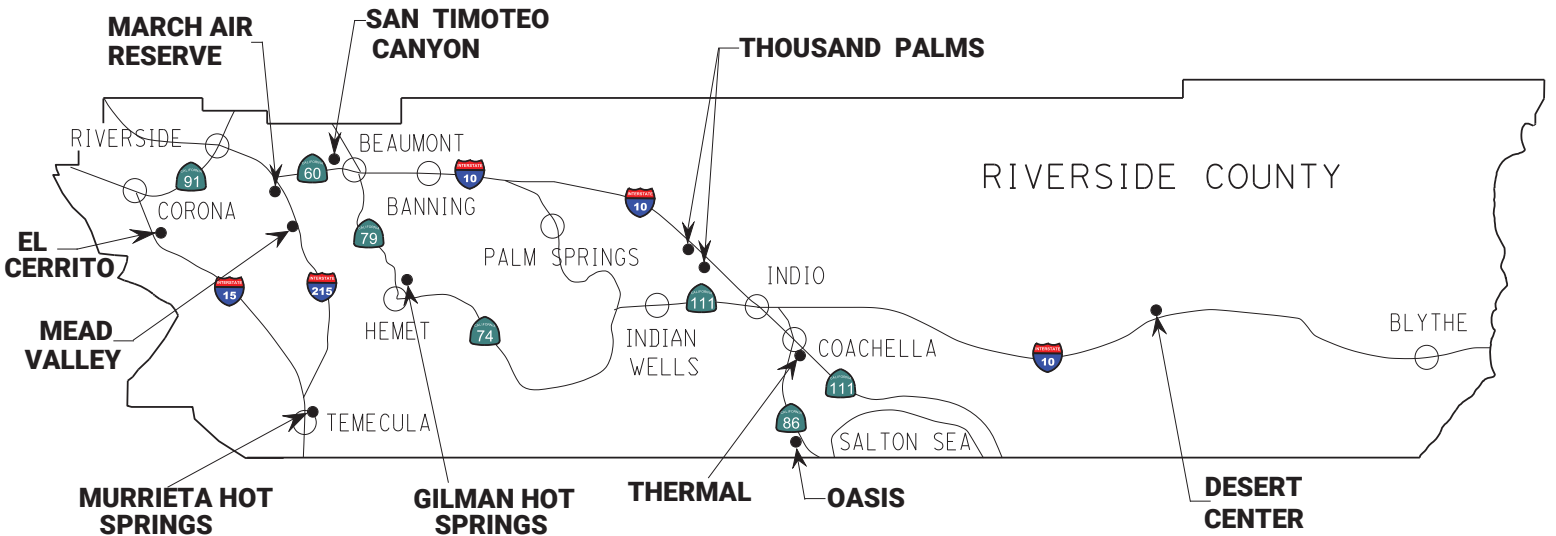
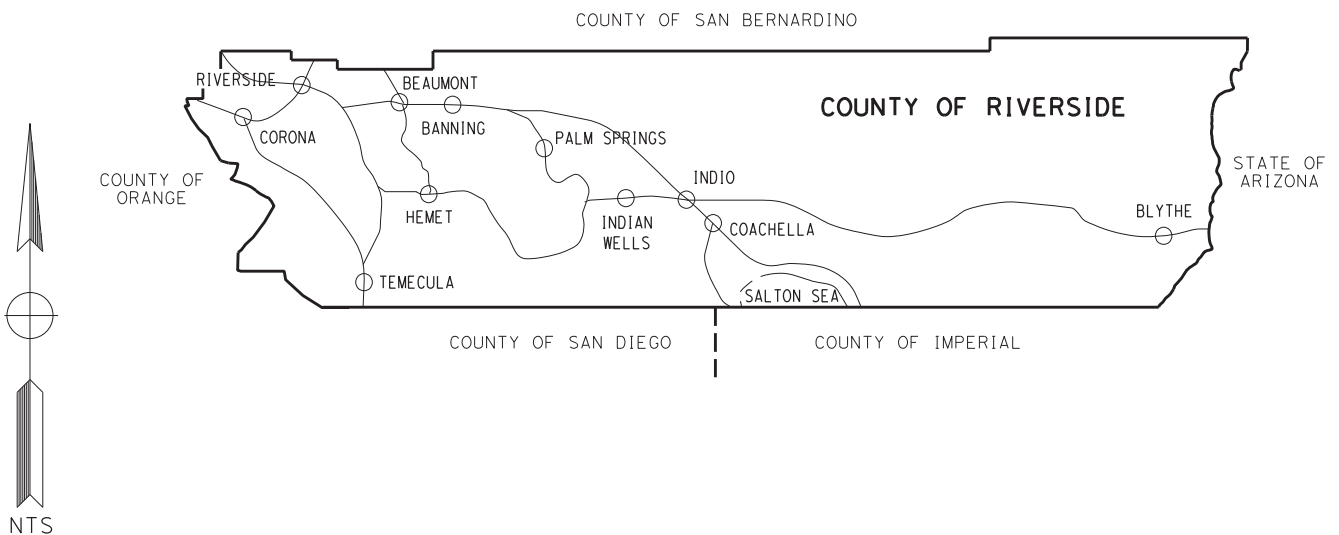
