

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The Coachella Valley History Museum is working to develop a 15,000 sq ft outdoor space into a Gardens & Railway exhibit, dedicated to preserving the railway history and water conservation. In October 2024 a 1950 stainless steel railcar was delivered and placed on the train tracks on the museum grounds. They are currently working on a revised site plan to include accessible ramp entrance, placement of the Desert Submarine exhibit and layout of all garden spaces. CID funds will support the outdoor Garden & Railway exhibit.

2. The Palm Springs Health Run & Wellness Festival is celebrating its 12th Anniversary on January 24, 2026. The event is held at Ruth Hardy Park in Palm Springs and provides free health screenings, vaccines and wellness information at no cost. CID funds will help cover expenses of the event.

3. The Palm Springs Air Museum will host their annual educational fundraising gala on February 7, 2026. This event raises funds for their commemorative educational programs which support educational, cultural, and historical significance programs that take place inside the Miles Hanger. CID funds will be used to offset the cost of free admission for guided youth tours.
