**SUBJECT:** SHERIFF-CORONER-PA: Approve the Amendment with Flock Group, Inc. for Flock Safety Long-Range License Plate Recognition (LPR) Cameras/Software without seeking competitive bids for two (2) years through October 20, 2027; All Districts [Total cost \$1,556,000; \$748,000 annually Up to \$155,600 in Additional Compensation 100% General Fund]

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the Amendment with Flock Group, Inc. for one hundred seventy (170) Flock Safety Long-Range License Plate Recognition (LPR), and Falcon LR camera annual subscription licenses without seeking competitive bids for an aggregate amount of \$1,496,000 for two years, through October 20, 2027, and authorize the Chair of the Board to sign the Amendment on behalf of the County; and
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459, to: (a) issue Purchase Orders to Flock Group Inc. that do not exceed the total compensation approved by the Board; and (b) based on the availability of fiscal funding and as approved as to form by County Counsel, sign amendments to the Agreement, including modifications of the scope of service that stay within the intent of the Amendment, and modifications to the compensation provisions that do not exceed the sum total of ten percent (10%) of the total aggregate cost of the Agreement.



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

On October 19, 2021, (Minute Order 3.27), the Board approved the Flock Group, Inc. Service Agreement Order Form (Agreement) for two hundred sixty (260) Standard Falcon Flock Safety License Plate Recognition (LPR) cameras without seeking competitive bids, extending through June 30, 2026, with an annual amount of \$650,000.

On August 30, 2022, (Minute Order 3.4), the Board directed the Sheriff's Office to initiate work on the Unincorporated Communities Initiative Project using the allocated resources from the Unincorporated Communities Fund. The Third District allocated \$100,000 to purchase thirty-four (34) Standard Flock Cameras to be installed throughout unincorporated communities within the district. On January 10, 2023, (Minute Order 3.41), the Board supplementally approved to increase the approved sole source limits to cover the additional service agreement for thirty-four (34) Flock Safety License Plate Recognition (LPR) Standard Falcon camera annual subscription licenses for Southwest Station with an annual amount of \$85,000. The additional cameras were installed within the French Valley area.

On January 24, 2023, (Minute Order 3.4), the Board directed the Sheriff's Office to initiate work on the Unincorporated Communities Initiative project using the allocated resources from the Unincorporated Communities Fund. The Third District allocated \$100,000 to purchase thirty-four (34) Standard Flock Cameras to be installed throughout unincorporated communities within the district. On May 23, 2023, (Minute Order 3.50), the Board supplementally approved to increase the approved sole source limits to cover the additional service agreement for thirty-four (34) Flock Safety License Plate Recognition (LPR) Falcon camera annual subscription licenses for Hemet Station with an annual amount of \$102,000. The additional cameras were installed within the Hemet unincorporated area.

On October 31, 2023 (Minute Order 3.36), the Board approve the Master Services Agreement with Flock Group, Inc. for five hundred thirty-eight (538) Standard Falcon Flock Safety License Plate Recognition (LPR) camera annual subscription licenses without seeking competitive bids for an amount of \$1,478,750 for one year with the option to renew for four additional one-year periods in the amount of \$1,350,000 annually for a total of \$6,878,750 through June 30, 2028.

On May 20, 2025, (Minute Order 3.70), the Board directed the Sheriff's Office to initiate work on the Unincorporated Communities Initiative Project using the allocated resources from the Unincorporated Communities Fund. The Third District allocated \$13,000 to purchase two (2) Standard Falcon Flock Cameras to be installed throughout unincorporated communities within the district. The additional cameras were installed within Hemet unincorporated area.

The Sheriff's Office is seeking the installation of one hundred and seventy (170) Flock Safety License Plate Recognition (LPR) Long-Range Falcon cameras. These Falcon LR cameras have the ability to capture high-speed vehicles across multiple lanes and long distances, even at one hundred (100) miles per hour. Flock Safety will conduct site surveys with the agency, in addition to 811 utility clearance before the installation.

Flock Safety is a public safety operating system that helps communities and law enforcement in over one thousand cities work together to eliminate crime, protect privacy, and mitigate bias. Flock cameras capture still images with date, time, and location which can be used during a criminal investigation. The cameras also assist in locating stolen vehicles and alerting law enforcement of vehicles associated with Amber and Silver Alerts.

Other local government agencies currently using Flock Systems include Los Angeles Sheriff's Department, Azusa Police Department, Covina Police Department, Hemet Police Department, West Covina Police Department, City of Beaumont, City of Canyon Lake, City of Cathedral City, City of Corona, City of Desert Hot Springs, City of Hemet, City of Lake Elsinore, City of Menifee, City of Moreno Valley, City of Norco, City of Perris, City of Redlands, City of San Jacinto, City of Temecula, and the City of Wildomar.

Flock Group, Inc. is the sole manufacturer and distributor of the Flock Safety License Plate Recognition (LPR) Camera. Flock Group, Inc. is also the exclusive provider of comprehensive monitoring, processing, and machine vision services that integrate with the Flock Safety Camera.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The use of Flock Cameras improves public safety and reduces crime by improving the crime solvency rate.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The Sheriff's Office plans to purchase one hundred and seventy (170) annual Flock Safety subscriptions for Long-Range Falcon Cameras for annual recurring amount of \$748,000, which includes implementation fees at no extra costs. There will be no additional impact to the general fund as funding was included in the Sheriff's Office 2025/2026 fiscal year budget.

Flock Group, Inc. provides a discounted government rate of \$4,400 per camera for an annual subscription, which is a discount of \$600 per camera per year compared to the standard rate of \$5,000 per long range camera for an annual subscription. The total discount amount applied to the Flock Falcon Long-Range LPR is \$204,000. Flock Group, Inc. is providing the professional

services for existing infrastructure implementation at no cost by applying a discount of \$19,950. Flock Group, Inc. is also providing the professional services for advancement implementation at no cost by applying a discount of \$37,000. The discount from the quote reflects a total cost savings of \$260,950 through the next two years. The company also does not charge user license fees, saving the Sheriff's Office from additional expenses. If a camera has a manufacturer defect, Flock Group, Inc. will replace the camera at no extra cost. Flock Group Inc. also provides the ability to access additional cameras from Flock customers, including all local law enforcement agencies within the Flock network and within California, at no additional costs.

The Sheriff's Office is requesting an additional \$30,000 to accommodate Flock Group, Inc.'s professional service fees related to reinstallation of Flock hardware. Any subsequent changes to the deployment plan of installed Flock hardware, including relocating, repositioning, adjusting of the mounting, removing foliage, replacement, changes to heights of poles, incurs a fee. A replacement fee will incur if Flock Hardware is lost, stolen, or damaged. All fees are per reinstall or required visit.

Additionally, the Sheriff's Office seeks a 10% contingency amount of \$155,600 to absorb any possible price increases that align with the Consumer Price Index.

## FLOCK GROUP INC. AMENDMENT

This amendment (the “**Amendment**”) is made between Flock Group Inc. (“**Flock**”) and CA - Riverside County SO (“**Customer**”), collectively referred to as (the “**Parties**”).

1. Scope. This Amendment supersedes and amends the previously executed agreement between the Parties, dated 9/24/2025, relating to the provision of services by Flock to Customer and any schedules attached thereto or incorporated therein by reference (the “**Agreement**”). The remainder of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
2. Conflict. In the event of a conflict between this Amendment and the Agreement or any previous amendment, the terms of this Amendment will prevail.
3. Capitalization. Any capitalized terms used in this Amendment will have the same meaning as in the Agreement, unless expressly defined otherwise.
4. Effective Date. This Amendment will become effective when executed by both Parties (the “**Effective Date**”).

The Agreement is amended as follows: If the Customer does not utilize the purchased Reinstall Hardware services, the unused portion of the Reinstall Credit shall be refundable to the Customer. Refunds apply solely to the unused Reinstall Credit amount.


