BACKGROUND:

Summary

The City of Indian Wells approved the First Amendment to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement (First Amendment) for a modification of the level of service for FY25/26 through FY27/28. This First Amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Office with the addition of one (1) Deputy Sheriff – 80 position and the deletion of two (2) Deputy Sheriff - 84 positions. County Counsel has approved the First Amendment as to form.

The FY25/26 estimated law enforcement cost is \$5,573,600. The Sheriff's Office has included the cost estimate in its budget; therefore, no budget adjustment is necessary. County Counsel has approved the First Amendment as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is a First Amendment between the City of Indian Wells and the Sheriff's Office for law enforcement services, which the City of Indian Wells approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through the Sheriff's Office Board-approved rates.
