All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 4, 2026, at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface an approximate 0.7-mile segment of Contreras Road and a 0.5-mile segment of Johnson Road in the Community of Anza in Riverside County.

<b>Road</b>	<b>From</b>	<b>To</b>
Contreras Road	Johnson Road	0.25 Mile North of SH-371
Johnson Road	Contreras Road	0.50 Mile Easterly

Contreras Road is a two-lane facility that travels in the north-south direction with a road width that varies between 24 and 57 feet wide. Johnson Road is a two-lane facility that travels in the east-west direction with a road width that varies between 16 and 23 feet wide. The area in the immediate vicinity of Contreras Road and Johnson Road include residential areas with single family dwellings, vacant parcels, and open space areas.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed resurfacing project consists of grinding the existing asphalt concrete pavement in place (pulverize), mixing and compacting grindings with native soil to provide a base course, and overlaying the new base with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). At the end of the new resurfaced road segments, excess pulverized material will be removed, remaining base material will be graded, compacted and overlaid with HMA for a smooth transition to existing pavement.

Additional improvements include reconstruction of asphalt concrete dike, reconstruction of concrete and asphalt concrete driveway approaches, construction of asphalt concrete overside drain, and placement of safety edge and shoulder backing to protect the outside edge of pavement. Safety features include placing of traffic stripes, thermoplastic pavement marking, roadside signs, and other associated work.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

- Base Bid Schedule 1: Contreras Road and Johnson Road Resurfacing
- Alternative Bid Schedule 1: Frontier Communications Facility Adjustments

The adjustment of the facilities owned by Frontier Communications is also included in the bid package as an alternative bid schedule. If Frontier Communications approves the award of the alternative bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by Frontier Communications through reimbursement letter Agreement that will be executed by the Director of Transportation. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

**Environmental Findings**

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the Contreras Road and Johnson Road resurfacing project does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for an approximate combined 1.2-mile segment of Contreras Road and Johnson Road in the Community of Anza to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in spring 2026. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,001,936. The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 and Frontier Communications funds.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The County of Riverside Transportation Department (County) proposes to resurface approximately 0.75 miles of Contreras Road and 0.50 miles of Johnson Road. Contreras Road is a secondary road that travels in the South-North direction. Contreras Road is currently a 2-lane facility that ranges between 24 and 57 feet wide. Johnson Road is a secondary road that travels in the West-East direction. Johnson Road is currently a 2-lane facility that ranges between 16 and 23 feet wide. Additional improvements include:

- Adjusting utility manholes
- Grading shoulder
- Reconstructing asphalt concrete dikes
- Re-application of pavement striping
- Removing and installing various signs

No additional Right of Way or Temporary Construction Easements will be required to construct the proposed improvement.

**ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:** The resurfacing of the existing roads will be conducted by the County who is a permittee as defined by the Western Riverside Multi-Species Habitat Conservation Plan (WRMSHCP). The project is subject to compliance within the WRMSHCP. The project is outside of designated WRMSHCP Criteria Cells; however, it is still subject to compliance with the WRCMSHCP. Under Section 7.1 Covered Activities Outside Criteria Area and PQP lands of the WRMSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance projects, are Covered Activities and are not subject to survey or mitigation requirements outside criteria area and Public/Quasi-Public Lands. These covered activities are subject to compliance with Best Management Practices as described in Appendix C of the WRMSHCP.

1 – August 31), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act.

Preconstruction survey of road shoulders must be performed by a County Biologist before shoulders are graded.

The County has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

**Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities** – The proposed project of resurfacing existing roadways, is consistent with Section 15301(c) which exempts existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities, (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety). Furthermore, the project does not create additional automobile lanes and involves minimal to no expansion of use of the exiting roadway and associated facilities.

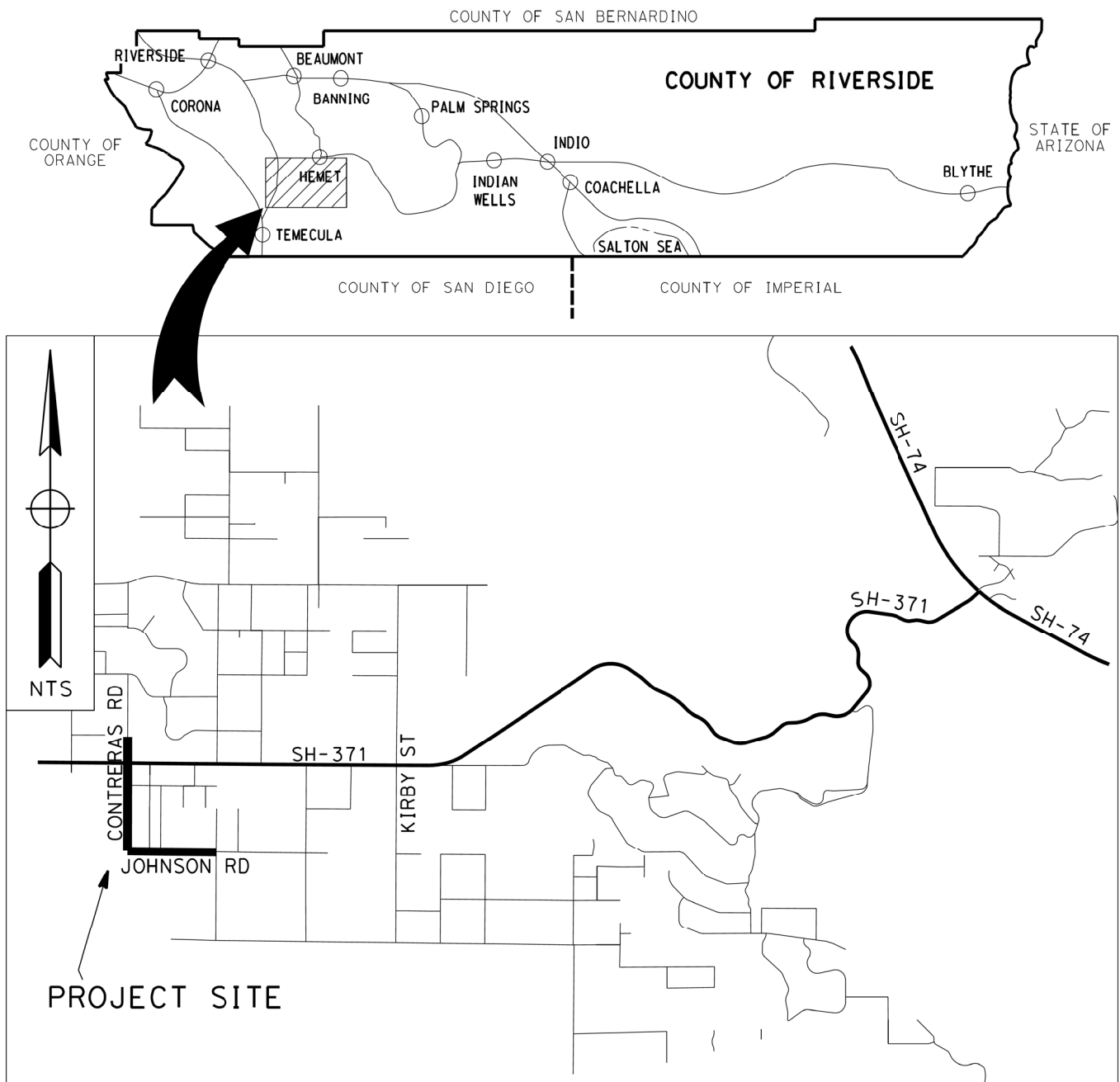
