2. The donation to the Riverside County District Attorney Crime Prevention Foundation (\$1,000.00) will contribute to a community event highlighting crime prevention initiatives and public safety partnerships that promote awareness and collaboration throughout Riverside County.

3. The donation to Temple Beth Shalom (d.b.a Congregation Beth Shalom) (\$5,000.00) will support the 19th Annual Legacy Luncheon, recognizing community members who advance religious, educational, and community-centered services benefiting local families and residents.
4. The donation to Circle City Rotary Club Foundation (\$2,750.00) will be used to further charitable initiatives that benefit local nonprofit organizations and community-based programs serving residents throughout the region.
5. The donation to Friends of the Corona Public Library (\$2,500.00) will enhance library spaces by promoting literacy, expanding access to reading materials, and improving signage within children's and teen areas.
6. The donation to Jurupa Area Recreation and Park District (\$1,500.00) will contribute to the Purple Power Event, a youth conference designed to promote leadership development, self-confidence, and open dialogue among young girls in the community.
7. The donation to Civic Rising (\$6,000.00) will fund a week-long Civics Summer Camp serving upper elementary and middle school students in Eastvale, Corona, and Riverside, providing instruction on democratic processes and civic engagement.
