BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Moreno Valley Hispanic Chamber of Commerce is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$1,500. Funding will support the Chamber's annual holiday Posada, providing meals, toys, and cultural programming for families in need while promoting community unity and engagement within the Fifth District.
2. Beaumont–Cherry Valley Recreation and Park District is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$36,000. Funding will support the District's 2026 community events held at 390 Oak Valley Parkway in Beaumont, providing inclusive recreational programming and family-friendly activities for residents throughout the Fifth District.
3. Riverside University Health System Foundation is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$1,500. Funding will support the Fifth District's attendance at the annual Festival of Trees Gala, which raises funds for pediatric, trauma, and critical care services benefiting children and families across Riverside County.
