RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify and Approve Amendment No. 2 to the Contract to Provide Legal Services for Indigent Defendants for Whom the Riverside County Law Office of the Public Defender Declares a Conflict of Interest or is Otherwise Unavailable with Blumenthal & Moore, a Professional Law Corporation; to increase the annual maximum contract amount by \$1,882,900 from \$4,454,000 to \$6,336,900 for the period of January 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028 and to provide a one-time payment of \$500,000 due to the actual caseload being significantly greater than contemplated at the time of bid and contract award, and authorize the Chair of the Board to sign the amendment on behalf of the County;

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

2. Ratify and Approve Amendment No. 4 to the Contract to Provide Legal Services for Indigent Defendants for Whom the Riverside County Law Office of the Public Defender Declares a Conflict of Interest or is Otherwise Unavailable with Peter J. Morreale, Esq. and Peter W. Scalisi, Esq., to increase the annual maximum contract amount by \$1,068,000 from \$3,875,000 to \$4,943,000, for the period of January 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028 due to the actual caseload being significantly greater than contemplated at the time of bid and contract award, and authorize the Chair of the Board to sign the amendment on behalf of the County;

3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459, based on the availability of fiscal funding and as approved as to form by County Counsel to a) sign amendments that exercise the options of the agreement including modifications to the agreement that stay within the intent of the agreement, and b) sign amendments to the compensation provisions that do not exceed five percent (5%) of the revised annual maximum compensation amount annually in accordance with the terms and of the agreement for the three (3) additional one (1) year renewal periods between June 30, 2028 through June 30, 2031;

4. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue Purchase Orders to Blumenthal & Moore, A Professional Law Corporation in an amount not to exceed the approved compensation amount for invoices received for goods/services rendered that are consistent with the agreement, as amended;

5. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue Purchase Orders to Peter J. Morreale, Esq. and Peter W. Scalisi, Esq. in an amount not to exceed the approved compensation amount for invoices received for goods/services rendered that are consistent with the agreement, as amended;

6. Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) copy and return two (2) copies of the amendment to the Executive Office for distribution; and

7. Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the budget adjustments shown on Schedule A.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside is required to retain legal services to represent indigent defendants for whom the Riverside County Public Defender's Office (PD) declares a conflict of interest.

On June 27, 2023, Minute Order 3.23, the BOS approved the contract to provide legal services for indigent defendants for whom the Riverside County Law Office of the Public Defender declares a conflict of interest or is otherwise unavailable with Blumenthal & Moore, A Professional Law Corporation for the Western Region. Amendment No. 1 is to compensate the attorneys for higher-than-expected caseloads than originally contemplated at the time of the bid and contract award.

On that same Minute Order 3.23 of June 27, 2023, the BOS approved the contract to provide legal services for indigent defendants for whom the Riverside County Law Office of the Public Defender declares a conflict of interest or is otherwise unavailable with Peter J. Morreale, Esq. and Peter W. Scalisi, Esq. for the East Valley Region. Amendment No. 4 is to compensate the attorneys for higher-than-expected caseloads than originally contemplated at the time of the bid and contract award.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

There is no negative impact on citizens or business in the County. The Legal Indigent Defense Services Agreements will keep the County in compliance with legal requirements.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The County of Riverside Purchasing, on behalf of the Executive Office, issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) #EOARC-652 on December 20, 2022, soliciting proposals for Legal Indigent Defense Services. The Executive Office has deemed this amendment to be fair compensation for the unexpected and on-going increase in caseloads and changes in circumstance.

This AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO THE CONTRACT TO PROVIDE LEGAL SERVICES FOR INDIGENT DEFENDANTS FOR WHOM THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY LAW OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER DECLARES A CONFLICT OF INTEREST OR IS OTHERWISE UNAVAILABLE BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND PETER J. MORREALE, ESQ. and PETER W. SCALISI, ESQ. (hereinafter "Amendment No. 4") is made and entered into by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, (hereinafter "COUNTY") and Peter J. Morreale, Esquire and Peter W. Scalisi, Esquire (hereinafter individually and collectively referred to as "ATTORNEYS").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, COUNTY and ATTORNEYS entered into that certain Contract to Provide Legal Services for Indigent Defendants for Whom the Riverside County Law Office of the Public Defender Declares a Conflict of Interest or is Otherwise Unavailable, approved June 27, 2023, Agenda Item 3.23, and effective July 1, 2023, (hereinafter "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and ATTORNEYS entered into that certain Amendment No. 1 to the Contract, approved July 11, 2023, Agenda Item 3.4, and effective July 1, 2023, to add all juvenile matters filed in the Desert Region Juvenile Courts to the Scope of Services and increase the annual maximum contract amount; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and ATTORNEYS entered into that certain Amendment No. 2 to the Contract, approved July 9, 2024, Agenda Item 3.8, to provide a one-time payment to the ATTORNEYS for all special circumstance cases where the People are not seeking death; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and ATTORNEYS entered into that certain Amendment No. 3 to the Contract, approved November 5, 2024, Agenda Item 3.10, to provide a one-time payment to the ATTORNEYS for the representation of both Defendants in case number INF064492; and

WHEREAS, Subsection 7.2 of Section 7. Compensation of the Contract provides if in ATTORNEYS estimation an extreme circumstance arises, ATTORNEYS may make a timely written request for additional compensation with complete justification from the COUNTY's Executive Office; and

WHEREAS, ATTORNEYS has made said request to the COUNTY's Executive Office due to ATTORNEYS actual caseload being significantly greater than contemplated at the time of bid and contract award; and

AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO THE CONTRACT TO PROVIDE LEGAL SERVICES FOR INDIGENT DEFENDANTS FOR WHOM THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY LAW OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER DECLARES A CONFLICT OF INTEREST OR IS OTHERWISE UNAVAILABLE BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND PETER J. MORREALE, ESQ. and PETER W. SCALISI, ESQ.

WHEREAS, COUNTY's Executive Office agrees that is an extreme circumstance; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and ATTORNEYS now desire to amend the Contract to provide ATTORNEYS with additional compensation for said extreme circumstance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. **Compensation.** Section 7. Compensation of the Contract is hereby amended to increase the annual maximum contract amount due to ATTORNEYS actual caseload being significantly greater than contemplated at the time of bid and contract award, effective January 1, 2026, by \$1,068,000, from \$3,875,000 to \$4,943,000, as follows:

“The Contract cost for July 1, 2023 through December 31, 2025 shall be a maximum of three million eight hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$3,875,000) annually plus expenses as set forth in Section 8 herein. For July 1, 2023 through December 31, 2025, COUNTY shall pay ATTORNEYS up to the sum of three hundred twenty-two thousand nine hundred sixteen dollars and sixty-six cents (\$322,916.66) per month paid in arrears upon the submission of an approved monthly report and an invoice for services. The Contract cost for January 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028 shall be a maximum of four million nine hundred forty-three thousand dollars (\$4,943,000) annually plus expenses as set forth in Section 8 herein. For January 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028, COUNTY shall pay ATTORNEYS up to the sum of four hundred eleven thousand nine hundred sixteen dollars and sixty-six cents (\$411,916.66) per month paid in arrears upon the submission of an approved monthly report and an invoice for services. It remains the responsibility of the ATTORNEYS to oversee the budgeted funds to ensure they are properly disbursed to provide the legal services required under this Contract. Should the Contract Term of Performance be renewed for three (3) additional one-year periods by a written amendment signed by the authorized representatives of both parties as provided in Section 2 of this Contract, the annual maximum compensation amount for the three (3) additional one year periods shall not exceed five percent (5%) per year of the annual maximum compensation amount set forth herein of four million nine hundred forty-three thousand dollars (\$4,943,000) annually plus expenses as set forth in Section 8 herein.”

3. **Miscellaneous.** All other terms and conditions of the Contract not modified herein shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
4. **Effective Date.** This Amendment No. 4 shall be effective January 1, 2026.
5. **Counterparts; Electronic Signatures.** This Amendment No. 4 may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which will be an original, but all of which together will constitute one instrument. Each party to this Amendment No. 4 agrees to the use of electronic signatures, such as digital signatures that meet the requirements of the California Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (“CUETA”) Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1633.1 to 1633.17), for executing this Amendment No. 4. The parties further agree that the electronic signatures of the parties included in this Amendment No. 4 are intended to authenticate this writing and to have the same force and effect as manual

This AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE CONTRACT TO PROVIDE LEGAL SERVICES FOR INDIGENT DEFENDANTS FOR WHOM THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY LAW OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER DECLARES A CONFLICT OF INTEREST OR IS OTHERWISE UNAVAILABLE BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND BLUMENTHAL & MOORE, A PROFESSIONAL LAW CORPORATION (hereinafter “Amendment No. 2”) is made and entered into by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, (hereinafter “COUNTY”) and Blumenthal & Moore, A Professional Law Corporation, a California corporation, (hereinafter “ATTORNEYS”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, COUNTY and ATTORNEYS entered into that certain Contract to Provide Legal Services for Indigent Defendants for Whom the Riverside County Law Office of the Public Defender Declares a Conflict of Interest or is Otherwise Unavailable, approved June 27, 2023, Agenda Item 3.23, and effective July 1, 2023, (hereinafter “Contract”); and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and ATTORNEYS entered into that certain Amendment No. 1 to the Contract, approved October 7, 2025, Agenda Item 3.6, to provide a one-time payment to the ATTORNEYS in recognition of the actual caseload for Franklin cases being significantly greater than contemplated at the time of bid and contract award; and

WHEREAS, Subsection 7.2 of Section 7. Compensation of the Contract provides if in ATTORNEYS estimation an extreme circumstance arises, ATTORNEYS may make a timely written request for additional compensation with complete justification from the COUNTY’s Executive Office; and

WHEREAS, ATTORNEYS has made said request to the COUNTY’s Executive Office due to ATTORNEYS actual caseload being significantly greater throughout the term of performance than contemplated at the time of bid and contract award; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY’s Executive Office agrees that is an extreme circumstance; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and ATTORNEYS now desire to amend the Contract to provide ATTORNEYS with additional compensation for said extreme circumstance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

2. **Compensation.** Section 7. Compensation of the Contract is hereby amended to increase the annual maximum contract amount due to ATTORNEYS actual caseload being significantly greater than contemplated at the time of bid and contract award, effective January 1, 2026, by \$1,882,900, from \$4,454,000 to \$6,336,900, as follows:

“The Contract cost for July 1, 2023 through December 31, 2025 shall be a maximum of four million four hundred fifty-four thousand dollars (\$4,454,000) annually plus expenses as set forth in Section 8 herein. For July 1, 2023 through December 31, 2025, COUNTY shall pay ATTORNEYS up to the sum of three hundred seventy-one thousand one hundred sixty-six dollars and sixty-seven cents (\$371,166.67) per month paid in arrears upon the submission of an approved monthly report and an invoice for services. The Contract cost for January 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028 shall be a maximum of six million three hundred thirty-six thousand nine hundred dollars (\$6,336,900) annually plus expenses as set forth in Section 8 herein. For January 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028, COUNTY shall pay ATTORNEYS up to the sum of five hundred twenty-eight thousand seventy-five dollars (\$528,075) per month paid in arrears upon the submission of an approved monthly report and an invoice for services. It remains the responsibility of the ATTORNEYS to oversee the budgeted funds to ensure they are properly disbursed to provide the legal services required under this Contract. Should the Contract Term of Performance be renewed for three (3) additional one-year periods by a written amendment signed by the authorized representatives of both parties as provided in Section 2 of this Contract, the annual maximum compensation amount for the three (3) additional one year periods shall not exceed five percent (5%) per year of the annual maximum compensation amount set forth herein of six million three hundred thirty-six thousand nine hundred dollars (\$6,336,900) annually plus expenses as set forth in Section 8 herein.”

3. **Compensation.** Subsection 7.4 is hereby added to Section 7. Compensation of the Contract to recognize the extreme circumstance of the actual caseload being significantly greater than contemplated at the time of bid and contract award, during the initial two and a half years of this Contract, as follows:

“7.4 In recognition of the actual caseload being significantly greater than contemplated at the time of bid and contract award during the initial two and a half years of this Contract, the ATTORNEYS will receive a one-time payment of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).”

4. **Miscellaneous.** All other terms and conditions of the Contract not modified herein shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
5. **Effective Date.** This Amendment No. 2 shall be effective January 1, 2026.
