BACKGROUND:

Summary

The City of Temecula contracts with the Riverside County Fire Department for Fire Services. The Fire Department requests the acceptance of the Aerial Ladder Truck and Fire Engine donation from the City of Temecula. Once titles are transferred, the Fire Department will be responsible for the cost of maintenance and repair of the fire truck and fire engine.

The transfer is beneficial to the City of Temecula as well as the surrounding cities and unincorporated areas. The apparatus will provide depth within the Fire Department as reserve apparatus and will be used within the Integrated Cooperative Regional System. The transfer of title will ensure that these apparatuses continue to be functional and available for the Regional System. It will also allow the department more flexibility to move the apparatuses to other locations when operationally necessary; however, the apparatuses will be stationed within the City of Temecula.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

There is no direct impact to the residents or businesses. The transfer of title will ensure that these apparatuses continue to be functional and available for the entire Regional System which benefits residents and businesses. It will also allow the department more flexibility to move the apparatuses to other locations when operationally necessary.

Additional Fiscal Information

The maintenance and repair of these apparatuses will be allocated through the Department's Cost Allocation Plan as appropriate. There is no net cost to the county or our partners due to this transfer.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The City of Temecula has been contracting with Riverside County Fire Department for Fire Services since 1990 and most recently approved their Cooperative Agreement on October 28, 2025, Agenda Item 3.19.
