Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 18, 2026, at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing improvements by installing traffic signalization and lighting at the intersection of Stetson Avenue and Yale Street in the Community of East Hemet in Riverside County.

At this intersection, Stetson Avenue is currently a two-lane major highway that travels in the East-West direction with a center double-yellow traffic stripe, and asphalt concrete dike along both sides of the roadway. Yale Street is a two-lane secondary highway that travels in the North-South direction. Yale Street is currently controlled by a stop sign while the vehicles on Stetson Avenue continue driving without having to stop. The area in the immediate vicinity includes residential areas with single family dwellings.

Project construction will include installing traffic signal poles and mast-arms, safety lighting, traffic signal cabinets and pull-boxes, video and radar detection units, constructing ADA (American with Disabilities Act) compliant concrete curb ramps at all four corners, reconstruction of existing concrete cross gutter and spandrels, removing existing conflicting traffic striping and signs, installing new traffic striping and signs, and other associated work.

The intersection restriping will provide left turn pockets at Stetson Avenue for traffic traveling eastbound or westbound to transition and turn either northbound or southbound onto Yale Street.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

The project proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Stetson Avenue and Yale Street. This improvement is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because it does not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements at the Stetson Avenue and Yale Street intersection.

The work is scheduled to begin in spring 2026. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$738,413. The County improvements will be funded with West County Development Impact Fee (DIF) Signal Mitigation funds. The DIF program, which is governed under Ordinance 659, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded by the County gas tax.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

PROJECT LOCATION: The intersection of Stetson Avenue and Yale Street, in the community of East Hemet, Riverside County, CA.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Stetson Avenue and Yale Street in the East Hemet area of Riverside County. Stetson Avenue is a 2-lane major road that travels in the east-west direction. Existing pavement width is approximately 42' wide with dikes along the roadway. Yale Street is a 2-lane collector street that travels in the north-south direction. Existing pavement width is approximately 40' wide.

The project scope includes installing ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) compliant curb ramps at all four corners, striping modifications for left turn lanes on Stetson Avenue, curb and gutter as well as a signal installation at the intersection of Stetson Avenue and Yale Street by installing traffic signal poles, signal mast arms, cabinets, conduits, pullboxes, and other traffic signal equipment.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS: The installation of a signal and restriping of the road will be conducted by the County, who is a permittee as defined by the Western Riverside Multi-Species Habitat Conservation Plan (WRMSHCP). The project is outside of designated MSHCP Criteria Cells; however, it is still subject to compliance with the WRCMSHCP. Under Section 7.1 Covered Activities Outside Criteria Area and PQP lands of the MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance projects are Covered Activities and are not subject to survey or mitigation requirements outside criteria area and Public/Quasi-Public Lands. These covered activities are subject to compliance with Best Management Practices as described in Appendix C of the WRMSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act.

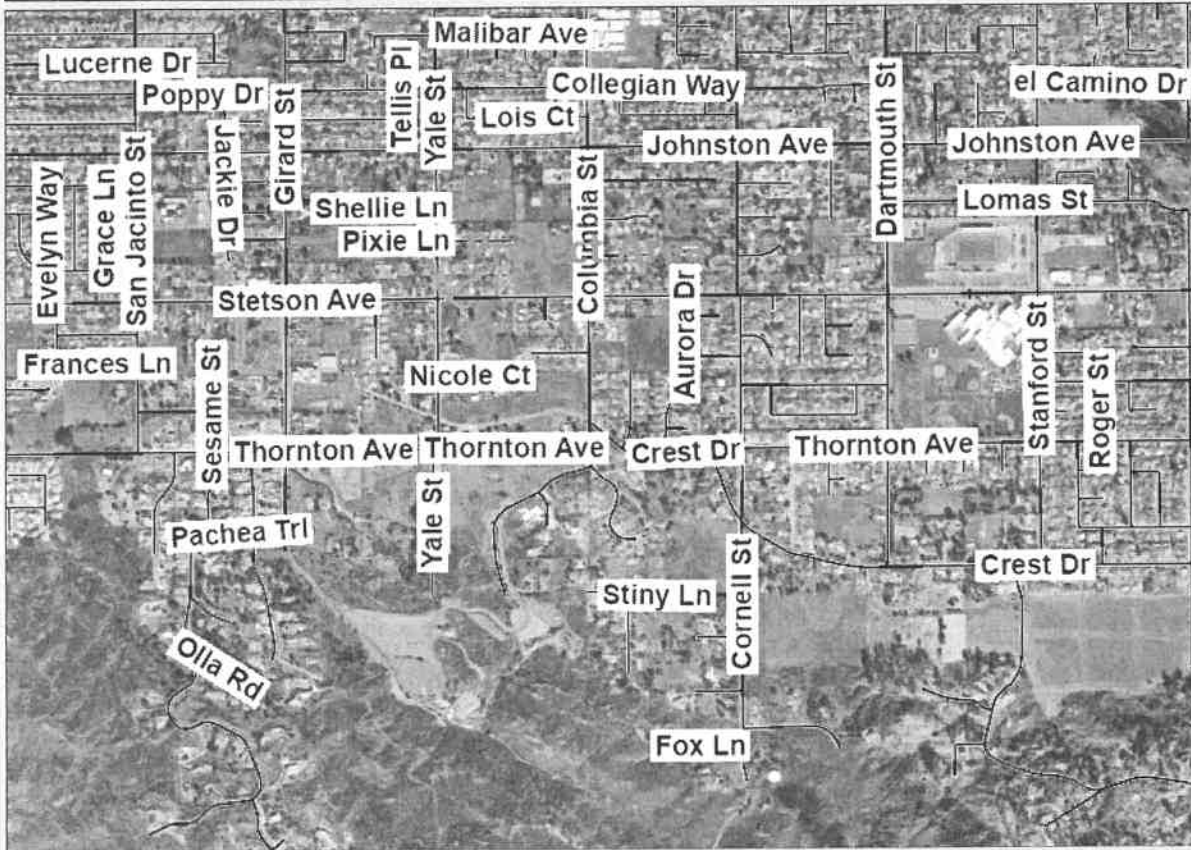

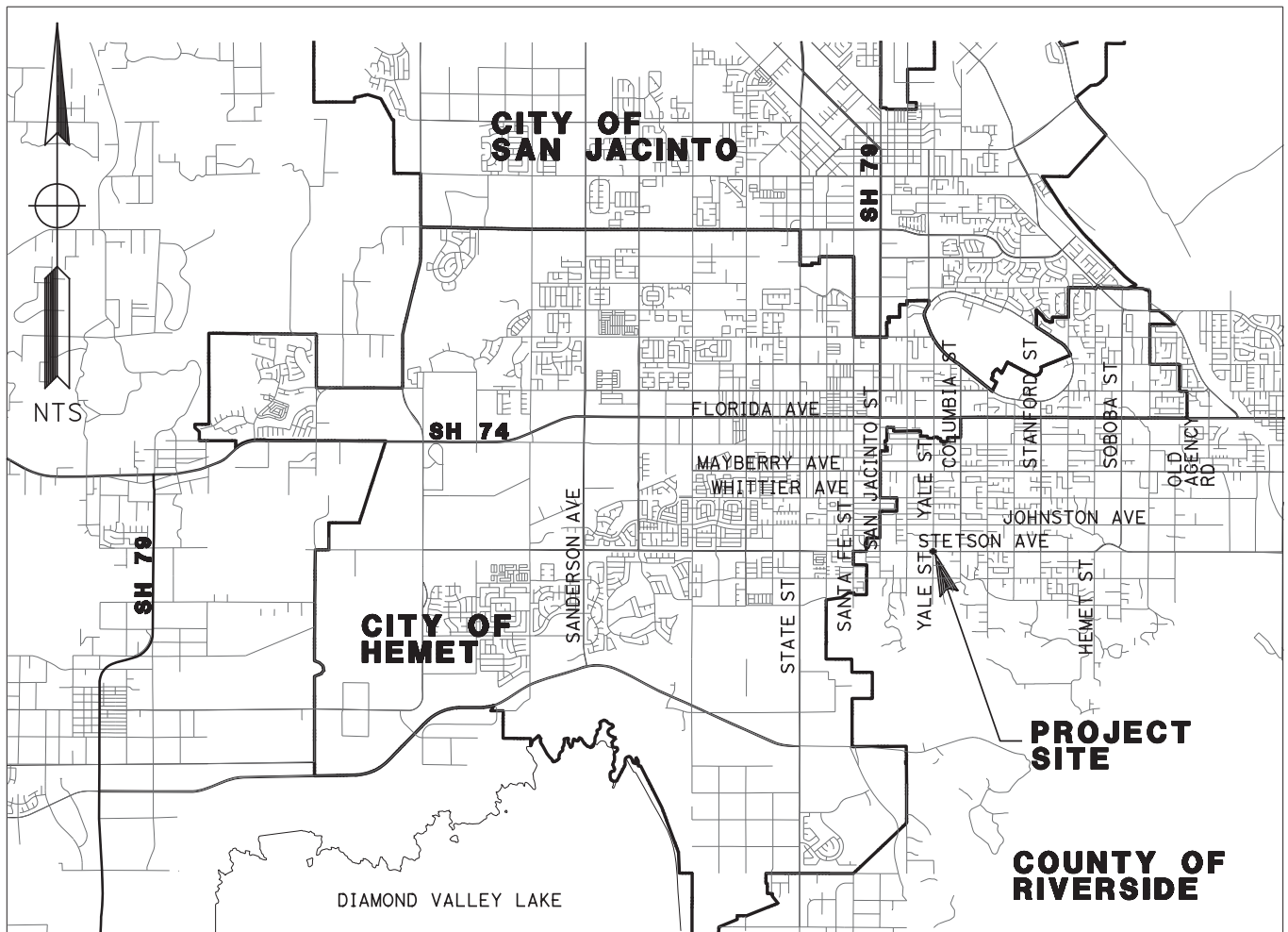
