BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to Riverside Community College District Foundation (\$6,000.00) will support the 4th Annual Industry Partners Event. This event brings faculty, employers, and workforce partners together for meaningful dialogue on industry trends, workforce needs, and curriculum alignment. The event strengthens collaboration between education and industry to better prepare students for regional employment opportunities.
2. The donation to the Riverside County Office of Education (\$5,000.00) will support the Corona–Norco Student of the Month Program. The program recognizes one graduating senior from each participating high school for character, leadership, and perseverance. Honorees are eligible to receive a scholarship to assist with their continued postsecondary education.
3. The donation to Blue Star Mothers HOME CA30 (\$3,000.00) will support Operation Troop Task Force. Funding will assist with the annual VetsGiving Dinner, food services, and ongoing psychotherapy and music therapy provided at the Veterans

Center in the City of Corona. These services promote wellness, connection, and mental health support for veterans and their families.

4. The donation to Lake Norconian Club Foundation (\$5,000.00) will support the Freedom Fighters Memorial Project. The project will create a permanent memorial honoring five previously unrecognized World War II Freedom Fighters. The memorial will be placed at the George A. Ingalls Veterans Memorial Plaza and serve as a lasting tribute to their service and sacrifice.
5. The donation to Riverside Voiture Locale No. 394, Forty et Eight (\$1,500.00) will help fund child welfare programs throughout the Second District. These programs include youth sports activities and pediatric therapy services that support the physical, emotional, and developmental well-being of children within the community.
6. The donation to the Rotary Club of Corona (\$1,500.00) will provide funding for youth focused programs and non-profits within the community. Support will assist initiatives that promote youth development, leadership, education, and service opportunities that create positive long-term community impact.
7. The donation to Inland Southern California United Way (\$10,000.00) will support the Employee Giving Campaign by providing funding to the American Cancer Society. This contribution supports community health through cancer research, prevention education, and patient support services while promoting employee engagement in philanthropic efforts that benefit residents of Riverside County.
