**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to Inland Empire Community Foundation (\$2,500.00) will support the Women's Giving Fund. The fund creates opportunities to educate and engage women throughout the Inland Empire on the impact of collaborative philanthropy. This initiative strengthens community investment by empowering women to collectively support local nonprofit programs and services.
2. The donation to Riverside County Deputy Sheriff Relief Foundation (\$4,000.00) will provide critical financial assistance to individuals and families experiencing unforeseen hardship. Assistance supports medical emergencies, funeral expenses, and other urgent needs impacting sworn personnel and their families. The foundation also supports community-focused programs that promote wellness and stability within Riverside County.
3. The donation to Kiwanis Club of Norco Foundation (\$4,000.00) will support scholarships for students throughout the Corona-Norco Unified School District. Scholarship funds assist students with tuition, books, computers, and other

educational expenses. This support helps reduce financial barriers and promotes academic success for local students.

4. The donation to Woman's Improvement Club of Corona (\$4,000.00) will support philanthropic efforts benefiting active-duty military members and veterans. Programs focus on access to affordable housing, counseling services, support for physical and developmental disabilities, and connections to local resources. These efforts enhance stability and quality of life for military families in the community.
5. The donation to Riverside County Department of Child Support Services (\$6,000.00) will support the Fathers and Families event. The event is designed to bring fathers and families together while providing access to community resources and support services. This initiative promotes family engagement, parental involvement, and overall family well-being.
6. The donation to Trauma Intervention Programs of Corona (\$5,000.00) will support crisis response services for individuals and families affected by traumatic incidents. Trauma Intervention Programs of Corona provide immediate emotional and practical support to victims, witnesses, and survivors in the hours following a tragedy, responding 24/7 at the request of law enforcement, fire, and medical personnel.
7. The donation to Voices for Children (\$6,000.00) will support the Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) Program. The CASA Program trains and supports volunteers who advocate for children involved in the dependency court system due to abuse or neglect. This program promotes stability and positive outcomes by ensuring that children's best interests are represented throughout the court process.
