

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The City of Lake Elsinore contracts with the Riverside County Fire Department for Fire Services. The Fire Department requests the acceptance of a 2014 Aerial Ladder Truck donation from the City of Lake Elsinore. Once the title is transferred, the Fire Department will be responsible for the cost of maintenance and repair of the fire truck.

The transfer is beneficial to the City of Lake Elsinore as well as the surrounding cities and unincorporated areas. The apparatus will provide depth within the Fire Department as a reserve apparatus and will be used within the Integrated Cooperative Regional System. The transfer of title will ensure that this apparatus continues to be functional and available for the Regional System. It will also allow the department more flexibility to move the apparatus to other locations when operationally necessary; however, the apparatus will be stationed within the City of Lake Elsinore.

The vehicle is identified as:

Impact on Residents and Businesses

There is no direct impact to residents or businesses. The transfer of title will ensure that this apparatus continues to be functional and available for the entire Regional System which benefits residents and businesses. It will also allow the department more flexibility to move the apparatus to other locations when operationally necessary.

Additional Fiscal Information

The maintenance and repair of these apparatuses will be allocated through the Department's Cost Allocation Plan as appropriate. There is no net cost to the county or our partners due to this transfer.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The City of Lake Elsinore has been contracting with Riverside County Fire Department for Fire Services since 1990 and most recently approved their Cooperative Agreement on June 13, 2023, Agenda Item 3.12.
