BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated October 28, 2025 (Agenda Item 3.40), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Alexander Street Resurfacing Project, in the Community of Mead Valley.

The project consists of resurfacing an approximate 1.2-miles segment of Alexander Street from Cajalco Road to Markham Street in the Community of Mead Valley of Riverside County.

Alexander Street is classified as a secondary highway in the circulation element of the County of Riverside's General Plan. Alexander Street is currently a two-lane road with a pavement width that ranges between 24 and 26 feet and with asphalt concrete dike along various segments of the roadway.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement condition, which is generally associated with age and weathering. The proposed resurfacing project consists of two treatment types distributed on various segments of Alexander Street. The first treatment consists of removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing back Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). The second treatment consist of grinding existing asphalt concrete in place (pulverize), mixing and compacting grindings with native soil with a small percentage of added cement to provide a stabilized base course and overlaying the new base with HMA.

A 168-foot segment of Alexander Street will be reconstructed by removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing a concrete dip section to solve flooding issues.

Additional improvements include placement of shoulder backing, placing asphalt concrete dike and driveways, installing pavement striping, pavement markers and reflectors, thermoplastic pavement markings, removing and installing roadside signs, and other associated work.

The contractor, All American Asphalt, is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the contract documents.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for an approximate 1.2-miles segment of Alexander Street from Cajalco Road to Markham Street, in the Community of Mead Valley to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in early 2026. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two and a half months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2025/2026 and will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A total of seven bids were received on Wednesday November 19, 2025, ranging from \$1,476,238 to \$1,624,988. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The low bidder, All American Asphalt, submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$1,476,238 which is \$33,167 (2.2%) below the engineer's cost estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to All American Asphalt in the amount of \$1,476,238.

Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and All American Asphalt, hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, Alexander Street Resurfacing Project, Cajalco Road to Markham Street, In the Community of Mead Valley, Project No. D0-0064, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders. (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of **2018** as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda (**None**), (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

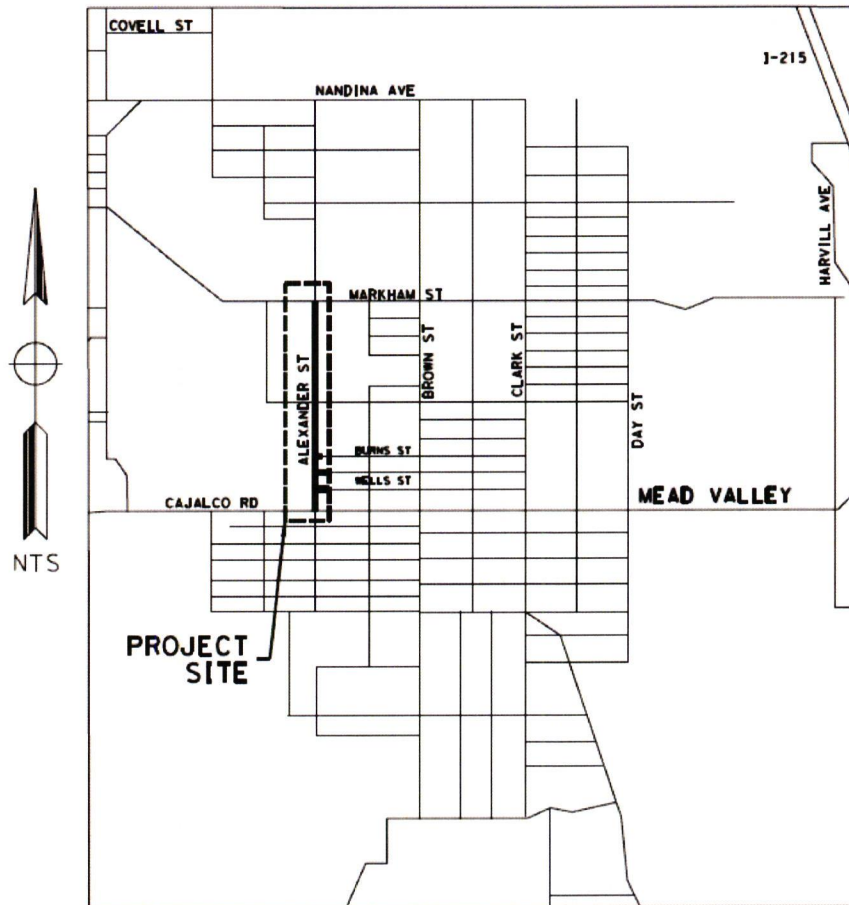
