**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

By Minute Order dated October 21, 2025 (Agenda Item 3.38), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Cajalco Road and Carroll Street Traffic Signal and Safety Lighting Project, in the Community of Mead Valley.

On December 3, 2024 (Agenda Item 3.82), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors approved the Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside (County) and Deemarco Limited Partnership (Developer) for the Cajalco Road and Carroll Street Traffic Signal Project (Project) in the Community of Mead Valley. The Agreement established the terms of the parties' responsibilities and cost sharing. The County is designated as the lead agency for the construction of the Project.

At this "T" intersection, Carroll Street is a two-lane local road that extends southerly from Cajalco Road. Cajalco Road is a two-lane road that travels in the east-west direction with a left-turn lane for westbound vehicles turning south onto Carroll Street. Carroll Street is currently controlled by a stop sign while the vehicles on Cajalco Road continue driving without having to stop. The area in the immediate vicinity includes vacant land on the north half and south-east quadrant of the intersection and recently developed commercial land on the south-west quadrant of the intersection.

Project construction will include installation of traffic signal poles with mast-arms, safety lighting, traffic signal cabinets, video and radar detection units, installation of new thermoplastic and paint traffic striping and pavement markings, roadside signs, and other associated work.

During the advertisement period, three addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the addenda issued on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award.

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STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. Addenda No. 1 and No. 3 increased costs; thus a 4/5ths vote is required. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 through Addendum No. 3.

The Contract includes the following schedule of work:

Base Bid: Cajalco Road and Carroll Street Traffic Signal and Safety Lighting Project

The contractor, California Professional Engineering Inc., is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the Contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the contract documents.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements at the Cajalco Road and Carroll Street "T" intersection.

The work is scheduled to begin in spring 2026. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

**SUPPLEMENTAL:**

**Additional Fiscal Information**

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2026/2027 and will be funded with Combined Improvement Fund and Developer Contributions Fund.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded by County from gas tax.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes Contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

**Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

A total of five bids were received on Wednesday November 26, 2025, ranging from \$341,649 to \$475,715. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The low bidder, California Professional Engineering Inc., submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$341,649 which is \$16,015 (4.9%) above the engineer's cost estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the Contract to California Professional Engineering Inc. in the amount of \$341,649.

## Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **California Professional Engineering, Inc.**, hereafter called "Contractor".

### W I T N E S S E T H

#### **Recitals:**

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Cajalco Road and Carroll Street, Traffic Signal and Safety Lighting Project, Community of Mead Valley, Project No. D3-0115**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

#### **Agreement:**

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

##### 1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of **2018** as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda **(Three)**, (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

## 2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

## 3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

## 4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

**DIVISION VIII MISCELLANEOUS CONSTRUCTION**

**73 CONCRETE CURBS AND SIDEWALKS**

**Add to Section 73-1.01 General:**

**73-1.01 GENERAL**

Concrete Items to be constructed are:

- Sidewalk per County Std 401 and as shown on the plans.
- Type D Curb per County Std 204 and as shown on the plans.

These minor concrete items shall be constructed in accordance with the plans, the County Road Improvement Standards and Specifications, as directed by the Engineer, and in conformance with the applicable provisions in Section 73 and 90 of Standard Specifications, except as modified.

The cementitious material content of concrete must be at least 505 pounds per cubic yard for:

Sidewalk and Type "D" Curb

**73-1.03 CONSTRUCTION**

**Add to Section 73-1.03 Construction:**

Preparation of subgrade for the concrete structures shall be done in conformance with the requirements of Section 73-1.03B Subgrade Preparation of the Standard Specifications.

Excess material resulting from the excavation of the subgrade shall be disposed of as provided in Section 00-1.14, 'Disposal of Excess Excavation or Materials', of these Special Provisions.

Except for existing Concrete Ramp located on the east side of Carroll Street, full compensation for the removal of existing concrete items (Concrete Paving / Concrete Island, and Curb) as shown on the plans; including concrete sawcutting, removal and proper disposal of portions of existing concrete paving / concrete island, existing concrete curb, grinding existing curb cut flush with gutter flowline; shall be considered as included in the contract bid prices paid per linear foot for Minor Concrete (Curb) [Type "D", 8" Curb (CRS 204)], and per square foot for Minor Concrete (Sidewalk).

Full compensation for the removal of existing Concrete Ramp located on the east side of Carroll Street; including removal and proper disposal of concrete ramp and adjacent sidewalk segments as shown on the plans, scarifying down 0.5' minimum, moisture condition, grading and compaction of underlying material, and backfilling with Class II Aggregate Base shall be considered as included in the contract bid price paid per cubic yard for Remove Concrete (Curb Ramp).

The Contractor is responsible for meeting requirements of American with Disabilities Act (ADA), the current edition of the California Building Code, and the draft and final versions of the Accessibility

Guidelines for Pedestrian Facilities within the Public Right of Way as published by the United States Access Board.

Construction of minor concrete items shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- 1) Removal and disposal of existing minor concrete items and existing soil and aggregate as required;
- 2) Establishing grades, and assuring that all grades are met;
- 3) Performing all moisture conditioning, grading and compaction of subgrade – including all required aggregate import, as directed by the Engineer and in accordance with County Standards;
- 4) Construction of new minor concrete items;
- 5) All scoring/grooving and required saw cutting;
- 6) If needed, repair of existing asphalt and PCC surfacing adjacent to minor concrete items, including slot cuts in front or around Minor Concrete items;
  - Surface repairs shall consist of replacing HMA over aggregate base in kind to match existing roadway structural section or as shown on the plans.
  - Alternatively, if approved by the Engineer, surface repairs can be 2-sack slurry cement backfill then cap with HMA, or a deep lift of HMA.
- 7) Installing 1/2" wide expansion joints;
- 8) All landscaping, and related work, to return the area adjacent to the minor concrete items to its original condition and to conform the area to the new improvements;

#### **DETECTABLE WARNING SURFACES (TRUNCATED DOMES)**

This work includes installing detectable warning surface on the curb ramps and on other areas requiring installation of detectable warning surface as shown on the plans, standard plans, and as specified in these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

Detectable warning surface must be:

1. Yellow color complying with Federal Standard 595B, Color No. 33538.
2. Raised truncated domes.

The manufacturer must provide a written 5-year warranty for detectable warning surface, guaranteeing replacement when there is defect in the dome shape, color fastness, sound-on-cane acoustic quality, resilience, or attachment. The warranty period will begin upon acceptance of the contract.

Installation of detectable warning surface must comply with the manufacturer's recommendations.

#### **Payment**

Full compensation for Truncated Domes shall be considered as included in the contract unit price paid per square foot for Detectable Warning Surface (Truncated Domes), and shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals for doing all work involved in constructing detectable warning surface, complete in place, as shown on the plans, as specified in these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer, and no separate payment will be made therefor.

#### **Replace Section 73-1.04 Payment:**

#### **Payment**

The contract unit bid prices paid per linear foot for:

- Minor Concrete (Curb) [Type "D" 8" Curb (CRS 204)], and

per cubic yard for:

- Minor Concrete (Sidewalk);

shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, equipment, materials and tools, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in the concrete structures construction including the grading and the removal of any obstacles within the areas of proposed concrete items of work including excavation, backfill, the furnishing and placing of expansion joints, complete in place as shown on the plans, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

**Item 4: Remove Traffic Stripes and Pavement Markings**

Refer to Section 84-9.03B, Remove Traffic Stripes and Pavement Markings, on page 30 of the Special Provisions.

Delete the 4th paragraph in Section 84-9.03B, and replace it with the following paragraph:

- B. Grinding: A minimum of 3 passes with the grinder in a rectangular area rather than just lettering or markings so the old message cannot be identified is required. Removal shall be to a maximum depth of 1/10". Removal depth may exceed 1/10" only when necessary to effectively remove paint, and only on approval by the Engineer. Asphalt emulsion shall be applied to the areas where stripes or pavement markings have been removed.

Delete the 6th paragraph in Section 84-9.03B, and replace it with the following paragraph:

After removal of traffic stripes and pavement markings, an asphalt emulsion coat shall be applied in conformance with the applicable provisions for asphalt emulsion found in Section 37, "Bituminous Seals" of the Standard Specifications.

**Item 5: Clarification, Archaeological Resources Monitoring**

Refer to Section 14-2.03, Archaeological Resources, on page 24 of the Special Provisions.

Section 14-2.03 applies only if cultural resources are discovered at the job site during excavations. Although not anticipated, if necessary, monitoring for Archaeological Resources will be provided by County.

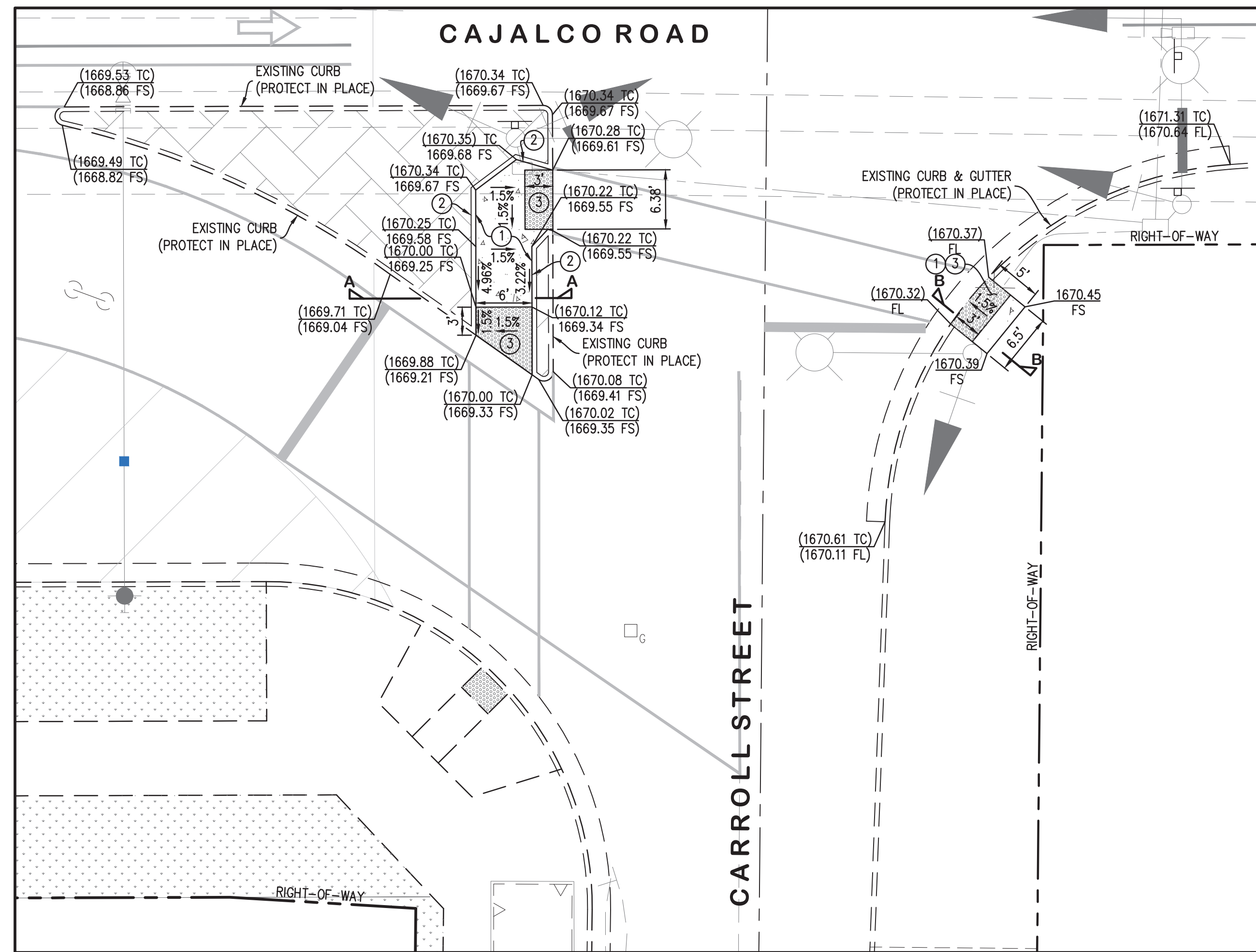

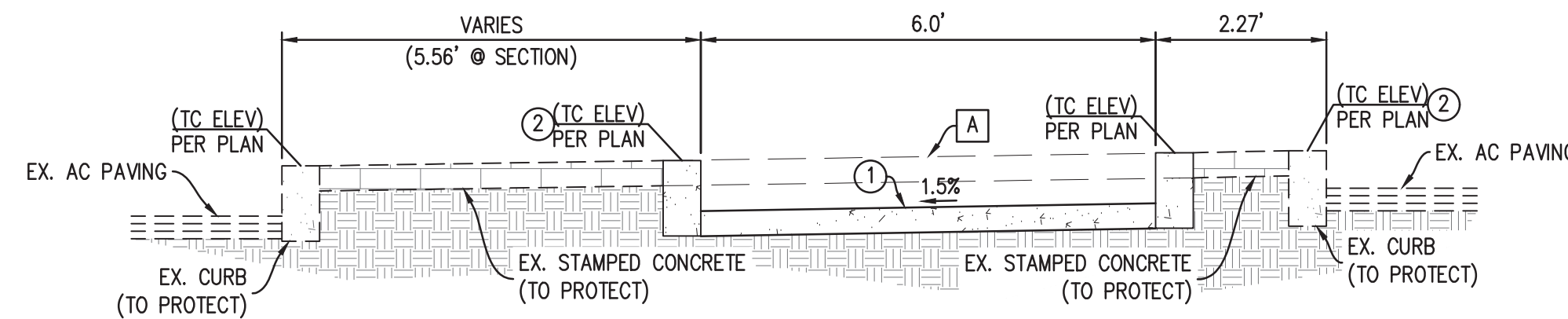


**CROSSWALK PLAN**

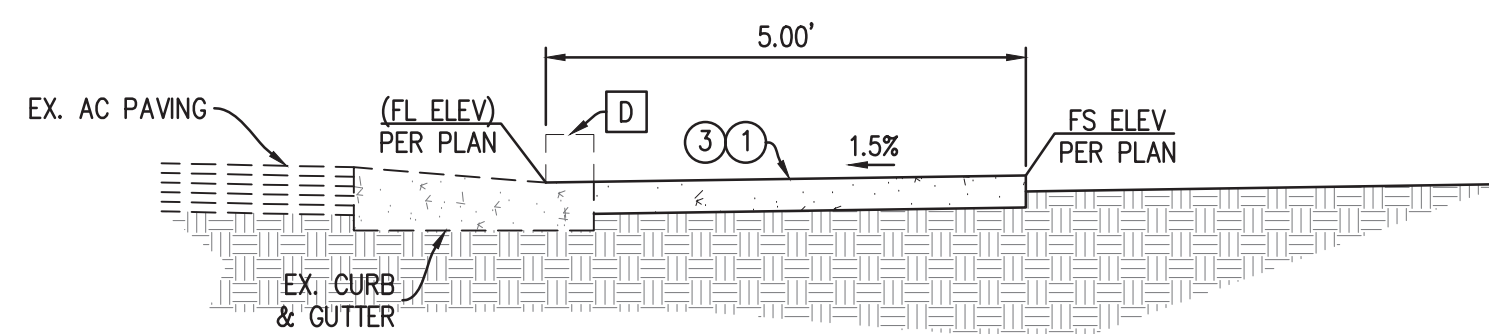

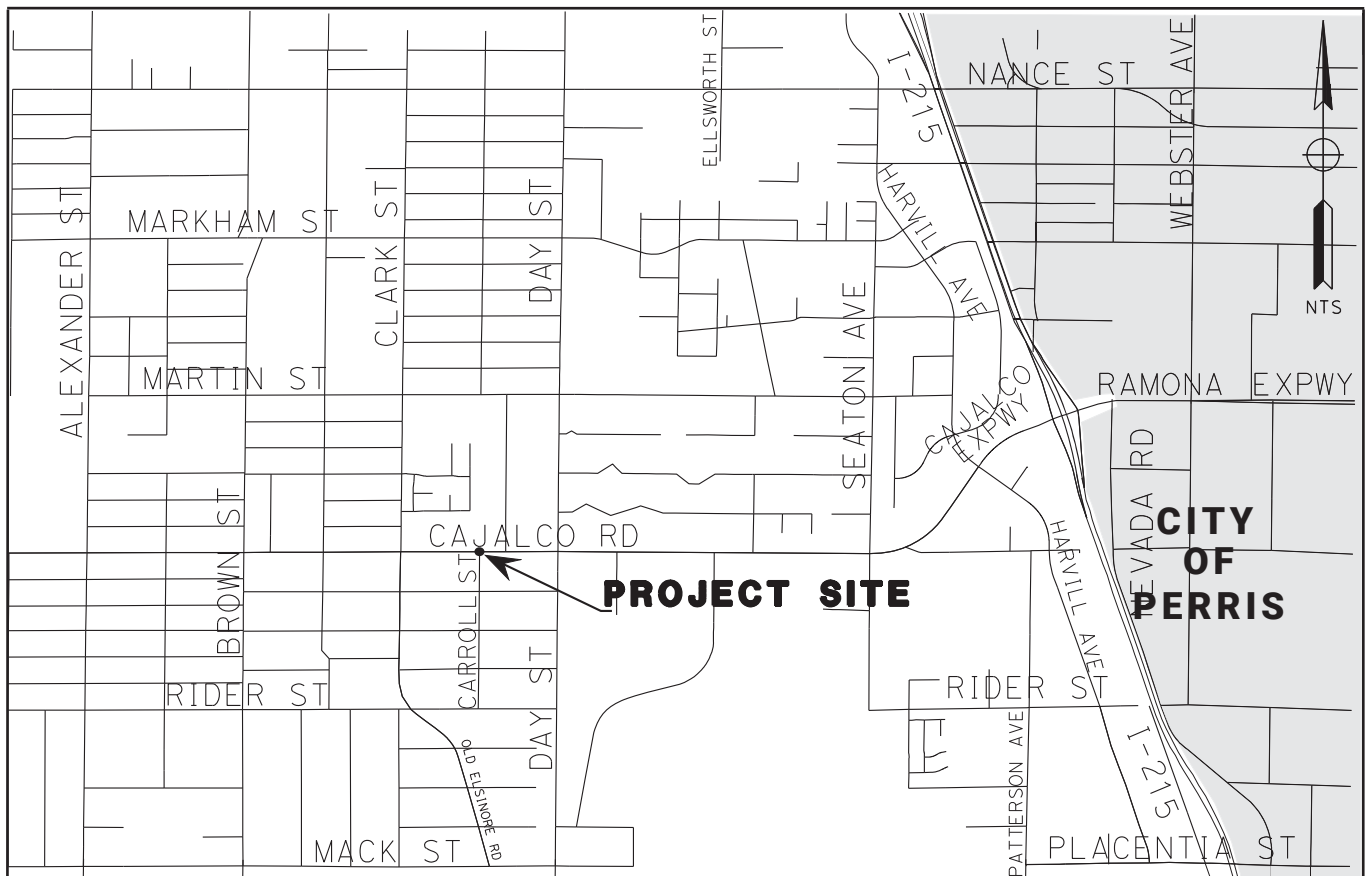
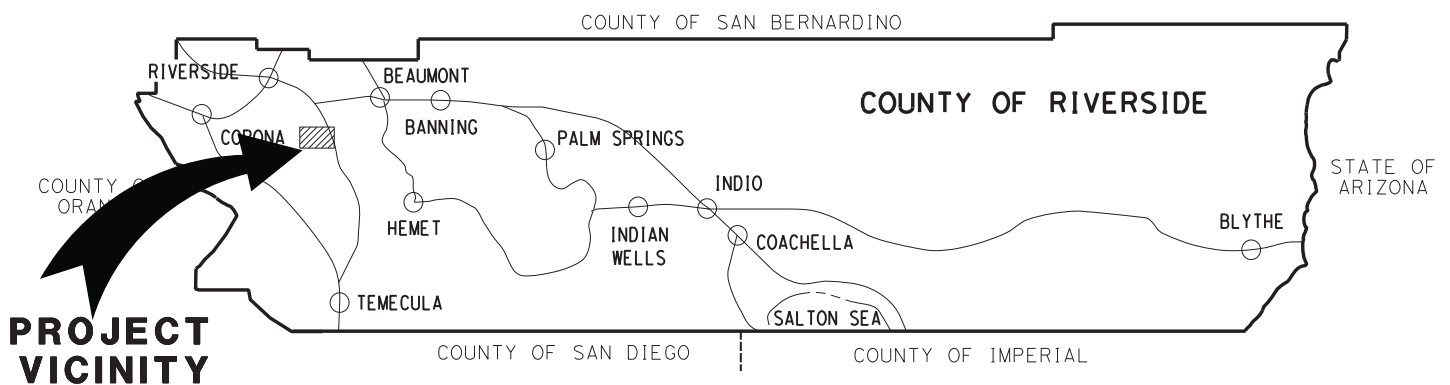
