 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 970, A MILITARY EQUIPMENT USE POLICY, OTHERWISE REFERRED TO HEREIN AS A SPECIALIZED POLICE EQUIPMENT USE POLICY, PURSUANT TO ASSEMBLY BILL 481 AND GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 7070 FOR THE OFFICES OF THE RIVERSIDE SHERIFF-CORONER-PUBLIC ADMINISTRATOR AND RIVERSIDE COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY

This summary is presented pursuant to California Government Code Section 25124(b). A certified copy of the full text of Ordinance No. 970.2 may be examined at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, located at 4080 Lemon Street 1st Floor, Riverside, California 92501.

Pursuant to the Government Code Section 7070 et seq. and California Assembly Bill 481, on May 6, 2025, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board of Supervisors") of the County of Riverside held a public hearing, introducing and amending a comprehensive Military Equipment Use Policy for the Riverside County Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator and District Attorney offices. The policy governs the funding, acquisition, deployment, and oversight of specialized police equipment, referred to as "Military Equipment," to ensure

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Key provisions include: 1) Definitions of Military Equipment categories subject to oversight; 2) Requirements for public input through hearings before adoption of the Use Policy; 3) Description of types of equipment, authorized uses, fiscal impacts, training requirements, and enforcement mechanisms related to Military Equipment; 4) Annual review and renewal process by the Board of Supervisors based on Annual Equipment reports; and 5) Procedures for public complaints and questions regarding Military Equipment use. This ordinance amendment aims to balance law enforcement needs with the community's rights and safety, mandating ongoing transparency and independent oversight.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE  
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 853  
REGULATING ROADSIDE VENDING

This summary is presented pursuant to California Government Code Section 25124(b): a certified copy of the full text of Ordinance No. 853.2 (Incorporating Riverside County Ordinance No. 725) may be examined at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, located at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California. In summary, Ordinance No. 853.2 amends Ordinance No. 853 in its entirety to ensure compliance and consistency with Senate Bill 946 (SB 946), other State law and County ordinances for the health, welfare and safety of the public by establishing regulations for sidewalk vendors and mobile food trucks operating in the public right-of-way. The regulations include operational requirements related to time, place and manner, as well as a requirement to obtain a Sidewalk Vending Permit issued in accordance with Ordinance No.499, and all other applicable permits required by State and local law. Also, Ordinance No. 853.2 changes the formatting and organizational structure of the ordinance for ease of use. Ordinance No. 853.2 would take effect 60 days after its adoption.
