4. Direct the Clerk of the Board to cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Riverside, California.



Summary:

As part of the Jurupa Road Grade Separation project, a road on a portion of County owned land has been constructed between Jurupa Road and Van Buren Boulevard, however, said road has not yet been officially named. Through coordination with the City of Jurupa Valley, it has been determined that said un-named road shall be named "Jurupa Connector Road."

The Naming an Un-named County Owned Road in the City of Jurupa Valley is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15061 (b)(3) and not a project pursuant to Section Section 15060 (c) (2) of the State CEQA Guidelines.

This street name adoption will have no impact on local businesses.

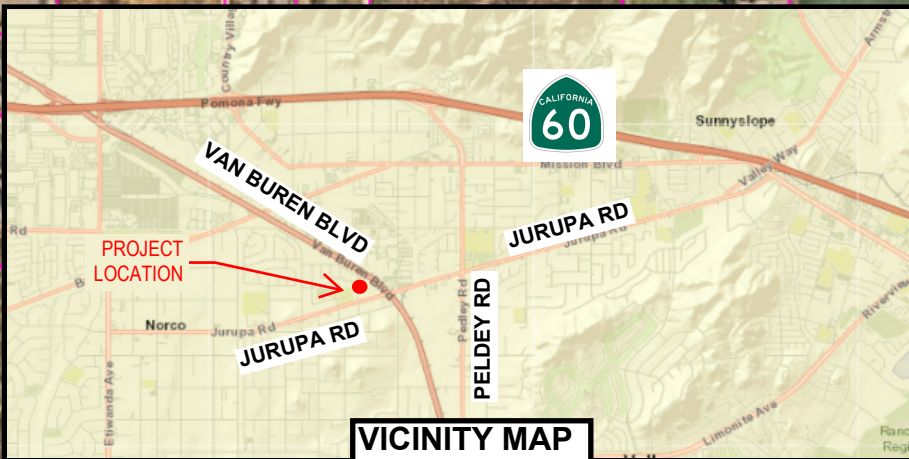
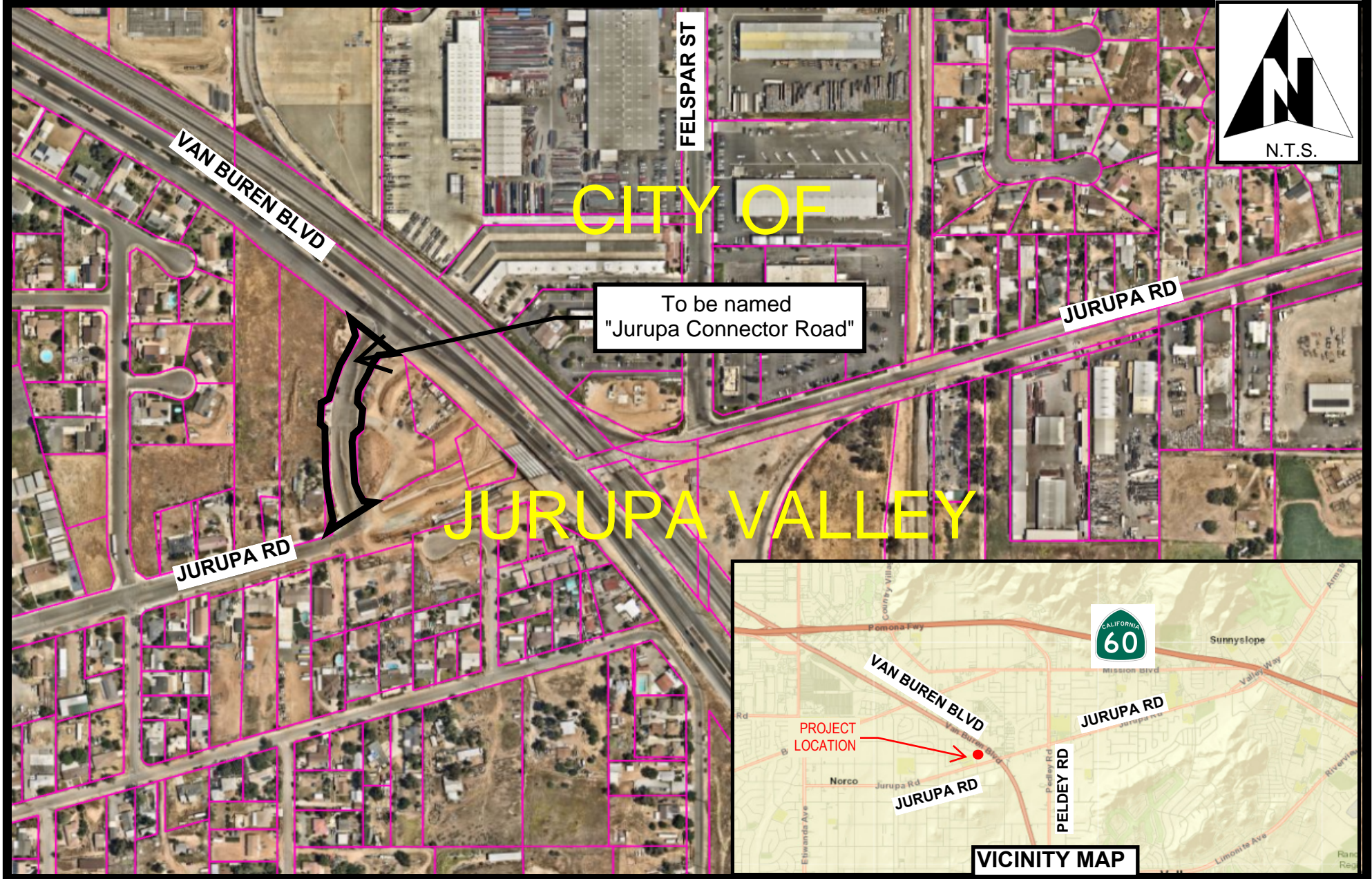
