**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the City of Lake Elsinore (\$4,000.00) will support the 6th Annual Mariachi Festival, which also serves as the official kickoff to Hispanic Heritage Month. This community celebration promotes cultural awareness, inclusivity, and engagement while bringing residents together through music, history, and tradition.
2. The donation to the Lake Elsinore Valley Chamber of Commerce (\$2,000.00) will support the 77th Annual Installation, an event recognizing businesses and individuals who have contributed to economic development and strengthened the local business community. This event fosters collaboration and leadership within the Lake Elsinore region.
3. The donation to the Jurupa Valley Chamber of Commerce (\$1,500.00) will support the Annual Community of Businesses event, which brings together business owners, community leaders, and residents to discuss economic development, community priorities, and future growth.

4. The donation to Before the Transition, Inc. (\$4,000.00) will support the 30th Anniversary Volunteer Recognition Military Ball, an event honoring volunteers who have provided Military Honors at Riverside National Cemetery for over 30 years. This event recognizes service, sacrifice, and long-standing volunteer commitment to veterans and their families.
5. The donation to the Riverside County District Attorney's Office – Victim Services Division (\$4,000.00) will support the National Crime Victims' Rights Week Candlelight Vigils. These vigils honor victims of crime, promote awareness of victims' rights, and provide a space for community reflection and support.
6. The donation to the Riverside County Employee Campaign (\$5,000.00) will support the Public Works Celebration and Rodeo for a Reason, a community-focused event featuring demonstrations, equipment displays, competitions, and educational booths highlighting County Public Works operations. This event promotes public awareness of essential county services while encouraging employee and community engagement.
7. The donation to Oak Grove Institute (\$2,500.00) will support the "A Day in Her Shoes" event, with proceeds directly benefiting Oak Grove Center programs for foster youth, including youth transitioning to adulthood. Funding will also support vocational training opportunities for foster and at-risk youth, helping prepare them for long-term stability and success.
