

**BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **California Family Life Center- \$2,500-** The funds will be used to provide trauma informed care and education to foster youth, and families facing challenges related to abuse, neglect, poverty, and family instability.
2. **California Citrus State Historic Park Non-Profit Management Corporation- \$1,500-** The funds will be used to support the 4th Annual Citrus Festival, an event that provides attendees with educational and cultural displays related to the citrus industry.
3. **Shoes that Fit- \$3,000-** This funding will support the distribution of shoes to children in need who attend schools in the Third District.

4. **Menifee Union School District Educational Foundation- \$2,500-** This funding will support All Star Field Day, an event that provides students with special needs the opportunity to participate in a variety of athletic activities.
5. **Helping Our People of Elsinore Inc- \$4,000-** This funding will support the DC Pantry, which provides food assistance to individuals and families in the Wildomar and Murrieta area.
6. **Oak Grove Institute Foundation, Inc. - \$1,000-** This funding will be used to support a Day In Her Shoes, an event designed to inspire women and provide attendees with access to career development opportunities and mental health resources.
7. **Riverside County Employee Campaign- \$5,000-** This funding will be used to support the Rodeo for a Reason and Public Works Celebration, a community focused event featuring demonstration, equipment display, competitions, and educational booths that highlight public works operations.
8. **Riverside County office of Education - \$2,500-** This funding will support the 2026 State of Education Address, an event that brings community stakeholders together to recognize educators, community partners, and students for the support they provide to advance student success.
9. **5&2 Compassionate Ministry- \$10,000-** The funds will be used to support the 5&2 program, a program that provides families in need in the Wildomar, Murrieta, and Menifee areas with an emergency food box that contains at least 7 meals per household.
10. **Riverside County Deputy Sheriff Relief Foundation- \$3,000-** The funding will be used to support a golf tournament fundraiser aimed at raising funds for families of deputy sheriffs, and other law enforcement and public safety officers who have been killed or injured in the line of duty. Support provided will be in the form of monetary or service assistance and goods.
