

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Banning Chamber of Commerce is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$17,000. Funding will support Chamber sponsorships, key community business events, and facility improvements that strengthen advocacy, networking, and economic development efforts within the Fifth District.
2. Riverside County Deputy Sheriff Relief Foundation is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support the Foundation's emergency relief and community assistance efforts, including financial support for public safety families facing hardship and sponsorship of fundraising events that sustain its countywide relief programs.
3. Moreno Christian Assembly is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support the annual Harvest Festival, a free, family-friendly community event in Moreno Valley that provides a safe and inclusive environment for residents throughout the Fifth District.
4. Time4College is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support mentorship, college preparation assistance, and enrichment programs for low-income youth and young adults in the Hemet and San Jacinto areas.
5. Hemet Little League is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$5,100. Funding will support the Challenger Division program by providing adaptive equipment, uniforms, and accessibility improvements to ensure inclusive baseball opportunities for youth with disabilities in the Fifth District.
