**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary:**

The applicant of Final Parcel Map 38153, also being the owner of APN 465-320-006, is requesting the acceptance of portions of Milan Road to satisfy a Transportation Department condition of approval for Final Parcel Map 38153. Said portion of Milan Road was dedicated for public road and public utility purposes by Tract Map 7027-1, filed in Book 118, page 39 through 40 of Maps, record of the Recorder of the County of Riverside, California.

Said portions of Milan Road have not been previously accepted for public road purposes by the County of Riverside. This action will accept said portion of Milan Road for public use but not into the County maintained Road System. The Transportation Department has reviewed this acceptance and has no objections.

As determined in the attached Notice of Exemption, the acceptance of a roadway is exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to exemption 15061(b)(3) and not a project pursuant to Section 15060(c) of the State CEQA Guidelines. This acceptance will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the exemption and will not cause any direct or indirect physical environmental impacts.

County Counsel has approved Resolution Number 2026-023 as to form.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The acceptance of the roadway will not impact residents or businesses.

All fees are paid by the applicant. There is no General Fund obligation.

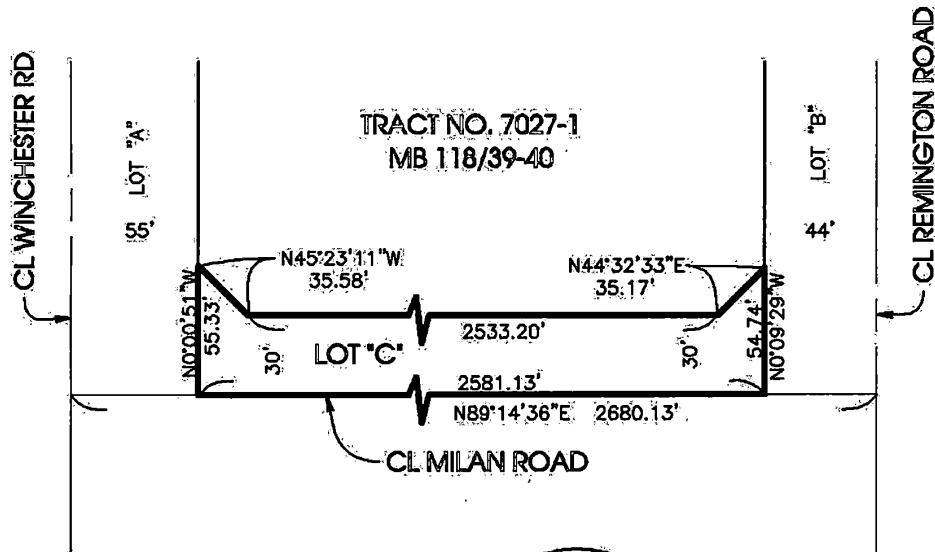
