5. Approve the project's proposed budget as shown in Attachment "A".



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated November 18, 2025 (Agenda Item 3.60), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Highway 74 and Mountain Avenue Traffic Signal and Safety Lighting Project, in the Community of Good Hope.

At this “T” intersection, Highway 74 is currently an arterial highway that travels in the Northeast-Southwest direction with four 12-foot wide through lanes, striped median and paved shoulders, with a 12-foot left-turn lane for vehicles turning west onto Mountain Avenue. Mountain Avenue is a two-lane facility that travels in the East-West direction with 12-foot wide through lanes and dirt shoulders. The area in the immediate vicinity includes residential areas with single family dwellings, commercial and vacant parcels.

Project construction will include installing traffic signal poles and mast-arms, traffic signal cabinets and pull-boxes, grading, constructing a retaining wall, minor pavement widening to accommodate a north eastbound left turn on Mountain Avenue and a westbound right turn lane on Highway 74, constructing concrete curb, curb ramps, driveway approach, and sidewalk, removing existing traffic striping and signs, installing new traffic striping and signs, and other associated work.

The Contract includes the following schedule of work:

Base Bid: Highway 74 and Mountain Avenue Traffic Signal and Safety Lighting Project

The contractor, DBX, Inc., is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the Contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the contract documents.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements at the Highway 74 and Mountain Avenue "T" intersection.

The work is scheduled to begin in spring 2026. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately four months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2026/2027 and will be funded with Caltrans – Highway 74 Relinquishment funds.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded by County from gas tax.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes Contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A total of three bids were received on Wednesday December 10, 2025, ranging from \$932,137 to \$1,233,905. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The low bidder, DBX, Inc., submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$932,137 which is \$14,374 (1.5%) below the engineer's cost estimate.

PTM General Engineering Services, Inc. (PTM) was announced as the third bidder; nevertheless, PTM requested to be relieved from their Bid without penalty. Public Contract Code (PCC) § 5101 et. seq. permits an awarding authority to relieve a bidder of its bid because of a mistake. The County of Riverside Transportation Department concludes that the information provided by PTM letter dated December 11, 2025 meets the requirements of PCC §5101 and §5103. Accordingly, the Department recommends to the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors to formally relieve PTM of their bid. Attached is a letter dated January 22, 2026 sent by Transportation Department notifying PTM of the Department's intention to relieve their bid by Board of Supervisors approval.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the Contract to DBX, Inc. in the amount of \$932,137.

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **DBX, Inc.**, hereafter called "Contractor".

W I T N E S S E T H

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Highway 74 and Mountain Avenue, Traffic Signal and Safety Lighting Project, Community of Good Hope, Project No. D2-0116**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders. (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of **2024** as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda (**None**), (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

PTM General Engineering Service Inc. (PTM) submitted the third apparent low bid for the above referenced project. By letter dated December 11, 2025, PTM requested formal withdrawal of bid.

On December 10, 2025, three (3) bids were received by the County for the above referenced project. PTM was announced as the third apparent low bidder after these bids were publicly opened.

Bid results were posted on the Transportation Department's bid summary webpage. Attached is a copy of the summary of bids for your use and reference.

On December 11, 2025, PTM submitted, via e-mail, a letter notifying us of clerical and mathematical errors made on your bid that created wrong unit pricings. The physical letter was received, via FedEx, on December 12, 2025. The letter requested formal withdrawal of bid. The County acknowledged receipt of this letter, via phone call and e-mail, that same day.

Public Contract Code (PCC) § 5100 et. seq. permits an awarding authority to relieve a bidder of its bid because of a mistake. The County of Riverside Transportation Department (Department) concludes that the information provided by PTM meets the requirements of PCC § 5101 and § 5103. Accordingly, the Department will recommend to the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors that PTM be formally relieved of its bid.



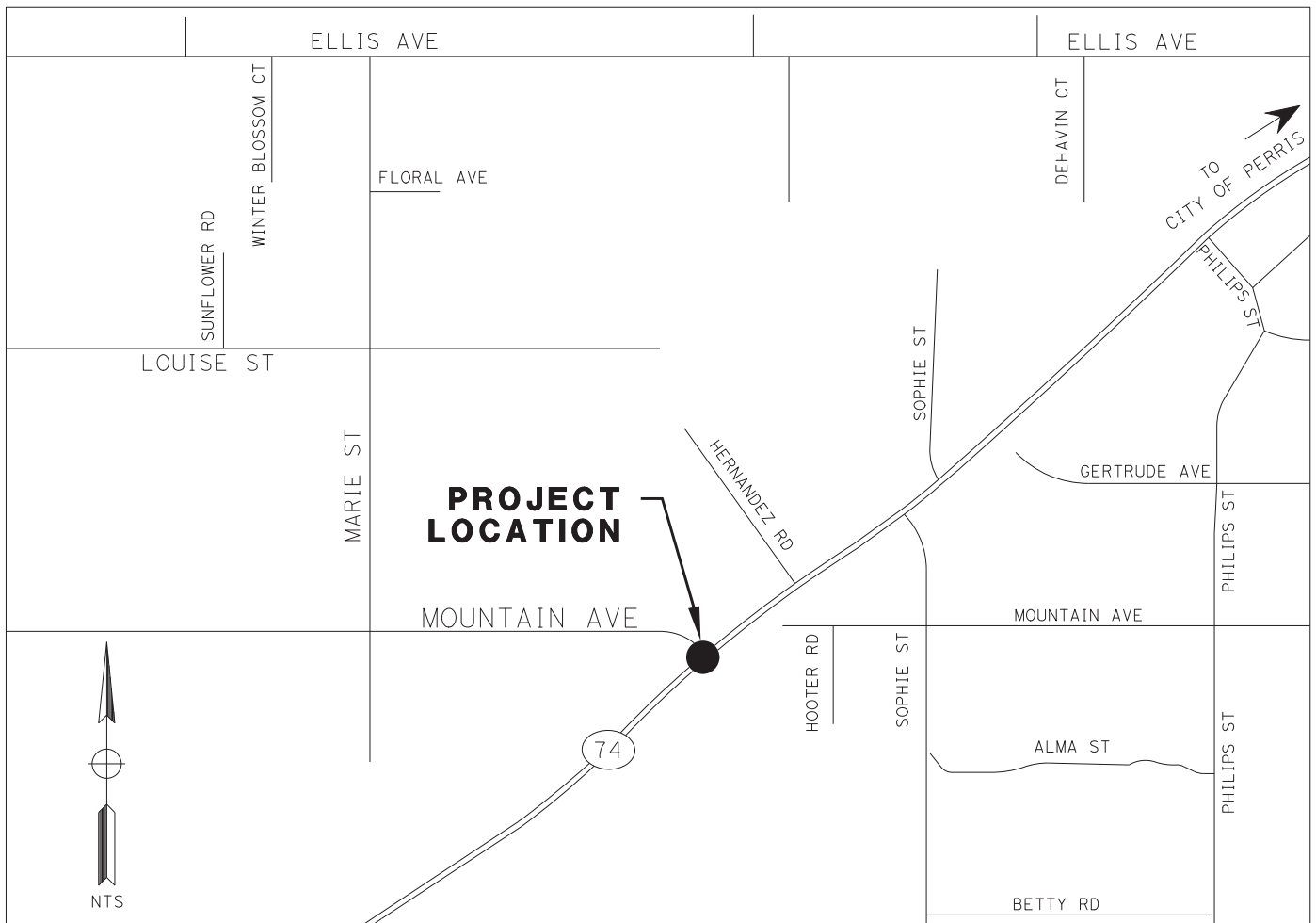
