- By Supervisor Spiegel: Karl Pfitzer, a beloved resident of Corona, who passed away on February 14, 2026, at the age of 86. He was born in Salzburg, Austria. He attended the University of Minesota and obtained his Doctorate in Physics. He met his wife during his time attending the University of Minnesota. After 35 years of service as a physicist, he retired from Boeing in 2004. Karl and his wife enjoyed traveling together.
- By Supervisor Spiegel: Richard Lachman, a beloved resident of Corona. He dedicated his life serving in the U.S. Navy during WWII. In 1955, he then worked at a pharmacy in Corona. He served as chair of the City's Human Relations Commission in the 1960s and was president of the Corona Jaycees. He also served on the Corona chamber Board of Directors and helped form the Corona Breakfast Lions Club. The Corona Chamber recognized Richard Lachman with the coveted Lifetime Achievement Award in 2021.

The Board of Supervisors commemorates their service to the County of Riverside.
