

BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:

The Temecula-Anza-Elsinore-Murrieta Resource Conservation District (TEAM RCD) is an independent special district dedicated to promoting natural resource conservation, public education, and sustainable communities within the District. Pursuant to California Public Resources Code section 9150 et seq., resource conservation districts provide local leadership in protecting communities, ecosystems, and public and private resources through programs and activities that advance conservation practices. TEAM RCD covers approximately 505,000 acres, including portions of Riverside County within Supervisorial Districts 2 and 3.

On October 27, 2025, Pablo Bryant resigned from his appointment to TEAM RCD, creating a vacancy. A vacancy notice was posted on October 28, 2025.

After reviewing all qualified candidates, Supervisor Washington nominates Arturo Garcia for appointment by the Board of Supervisors to fill the unexpired term ending November 30, 2026.

Mr. Garcia has experience in public service, community engagement, and grant management. He earned a B.A. from the University of California, Santa Barbara and currently serves as Associate Director of Local Government Relations for The Nature Conservancy. He previously worked in the California State Assembly, where he supported STEM-focused initiatives including the LA Mission College STEM Biotechnology Institute and the Pacoima Wash Connectivity Bridge and Bike Path Project. His background reflects a strong commitment to environmental stewardship and conservation.
